## MESSAGE FROM ARCADIA VILLAGE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome back our resident snowbirds. Not all are back but over the next several months the village will be buzzing with an influx of cars/trucks/golf carts, more pets being walked and residents walking around the village for physical exercise. It's time to exercise extreme caution when driving your vehicle or golf cart and keep in mind our speed limit is 15 MPH. Also, remember that we have stop signs and they are there for a reason. STOP means STOP!!!

Please be very careful going out the back gate as it's hard to see clearly if vehicles are approaching from either direction; most at high speed. As you know we had a very serious accident recently and lost one of our residents.

For our permanent residents we had a very quiet summer with lots of rain. We have seen many houses go up for sale (normal) and sold quickly, everyone wants to move into our beautiful village. I believe we are down to only seven or eight houses for sale as of this writing. We also witnessed the new pickle ball court being constructed and management purchased and installed two power generators. One was installed by the lake at the front gate, the other for the septic system in case of power failure.

I would like to welcome our new residents who arrived over the summer and encourage you, if you haven't already done so, to join our Homeowners Association.

Our next Homeowners Association meeting will be on 2 October 2018 at the Cantina Clubhouse @6:30 PM. All HOA members and nonmember residents are welcome and encouraged to join us.

As you are aware, at our last meeting in April, the residents voted that we hire a lawyer to resolve the problem with some committees not wanting to comply with turning in financial statements and money to the HOA. With help from Arcadia Village Management and our lawyer we were able to resolve the last hold out without issuing a court order.

Our Bi-laws with new amendment, that were approved by vote in April are being printed and we will make distribution to everyone on 2 October 2018. I see that October, November and December are going to be very busy months for the HOA Board and voting committee, as we get ready for our annual meeting and voting of new Officers. I also would like to remind everyone that if your HOA dues for 2018 are delinquent you will not be able to vote.

# Garlic Cheddar Chicken Bake



Prep	Total	Ingredients	Servings

## Ingredients

- 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1/2 cup Progresso™ plain panko crispy bread crumbs
- 1 package (14 oz) chicken tenders (not breaded), cut into bite-size pieces
- 1 cup uncooked regular long-grain white rice
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 2 1/2 cups Progresso™ chicken broth (from 32-oz carton)
- 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese (8 oz)
- Chopped fresh Italian (flat-leaf) parsley, if desired

- 1 Heat oven to 375°F. Spray 8-inch square (2-quart) baking dish with cooking spray. In small bowl, mix melted butter and bread crumbs until well mixed. Set aside.

- 3 Bake 45 to 50 minutes or until rice is tender and most of the liquid is absorbed.
- 4 Sprinkle remaining 1/2 cup cheese and the bread crumb mixture evenly over rice mixture. Bake about 5 minutes or until crumbs are light golden brown. Sprinkle with chopped parsley.
