## FROM THE OFFICE

The Arcadia Village Staff would like to wish everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

A few things to note:

Please stop in the office to visit Sylvia, inform her of any phone number, address or other changes that need to be recorded.

We have upgraded the front and back gates. If you would like to have your (any type of phone) phone number programmed please see Sylvia in the office.

Cigarette Butts belong in the ash cans, not on the Village streets. Please Keep Your Neighborhood Clean!

If you mow your own lawn please do not blow into the street and leave it there. We have clipping pickups 2x a week for this purpose.

### RULES & REGULATIONS REMINDER:

**RV Storage Update:** New Registration Stickers must be put on storage vehicles this year. We have new storage area guidelines that must be followed. Please make sure you get a copy from the office. If your area is weedy, please weed whack.

**Guests need to be registered** with the office and must carry a guest pass at all times when in the park. (If you have a 1-day guest, stop in the office during business hours.

**Golf Carts:** Florida State Rules state that anyone driving a golf cart must have an ID card or possess a valid driver's license. Children must be in the presence of an adult when in a golf cart. Please remember this rule is in place for everyone's safety.

**Speeding:** The Speed Limit in Arcadia Village is (15) miles per hour. This includes golf carts and any other motorized vehicles. If you see any outside vendors or delivery vehicles speeding, please report to the office with make, model and color of vehicle, as well as the license plate number, company name, vehicle number, etc. The more information we have the better chance of getting resolution.

**Maintenance:** Do not forget that you are responsible for the maintenance of the outside of your home all 12 months of the year, this includes weeds, plants, trees,

house washing, bricks, gutters, etc. In addition, if you have a storage space it must be kept trimmed and neat all 12 months of the year. We thank you for your cooperation.

**Renters:** must be approved by management. Please pickup an application at our office.

**Please!** when you walk your animal friends make sure you follow Park Rules that specify you must clean up after your pet. Carry a couple trash bags with you.

**Remember:** Any feeding, housing, harboring, or other solicitation of wild animals by residents is strictly prohibited.

## **RESIDENTS OF A STORAGE SPACE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FOLLOWING RULES:**

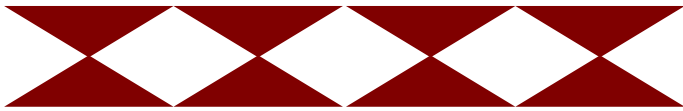
- ◇ Space may only be occupied by: RV, Motor Home, Boat, Trailer, other limited vehicle approved by office management.
- ◇ Enclosures/structures of any kind are not allowed.
- ◇ Space must be kept trimmed and weed free 12-months of the year.
- ◇ Space is not to be used for parking of cars or visiting guest parking
- ◇ All vehicles in storage spaces must have the parking permit displayed on the vehicle. If you change vehicles and need a new parking permit, it is your responsibility to contact the office to update vehicle type and obtain new permit sticker.
- ◇ All items in the storage area must have current registration/license tags.

Any storage areas not occupied for extended periods of time after season starts (typically October 1<sup>st</sup>) will be notified that the spot will be reclaimed by management.

Any storage area that is not maintained, trimmed, or kept free of miscellaneous junk and/or debris will be corrected by management and resident will either be billed or management reserves the right to reclaim and offer to the next person on the waiting list.

If there are no spots available, there are plenty of storage facilities within a short drive of Arcadia that may be willing to accommodate your vehicles for a nominal fee.
