### WELCOME

As residents return to Arcadia Village for the season, we highly encourage you to read the notices and guidelines posted at amenities, clubhouses, and bulletin boards and in the newsletter to stay up to date on what amenities are open or active levels.

COVID-19 is mostly **spread** by respiratory droplets released when people cough, sneeze, or talk. Someone can also get COVID-19 by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it and then touching their own nose, mouth, or possibly their eyes. COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms. Therefore, personal prevention practices (such as frequent <u>hand washing</u>, social distancing, and <u>staying home when sick</u>) and environmental <u>cleaning and disinfection</u>, as well as use of masks are important principles. (From the CDC Website)

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

<u>Chapter 8 – Mobile Home Maintenance</u>: All mobile homes must be kept clean, free from mold and mildew, and free from excessive dirt build-up and/or related unsightly residue. Prior to any exterior painting of a home, color samples must be submitted to management for written approval.

<u>Chapter 12 – Lawn Planter and related Landscape Maintenance:</u> It shall be the responsibility of the owners of Arcadia Village to provide regular lawn mowing service for your lot. However, it shall be the resident's responsibility to fertilize, water, trim, edge, weed, and otherwise maintain their lawn and other landscaping amenities on their lot. "Hand watering" only is permitted during reasonable daylight hours listed in the Village paper. Sprinklers are only allowed after receiving written approval from management. It shall be the further responsibility of each resident to maintain all other property of Arcadia Village which is affixed to their lot in the same condition outlined above.

This includes your RV Storage space if applicable.

During off season, I am tasked with inspections which means driving around to find any homes that the weeds are over grown either around the house or in planters and houses that need to be power washed. I then call home owner to make them aware. Remember it's your responsibility to have a designated person or company that will maintain your home while you are away from Arcadia Village for any length of time. I do put reminders in the newsletter for you toward the end of season. If you do not answer my phone call, return my phone call, or otherwise make me aware you are taking care of it, the office will have it taken care of and charge you the cost of cleaning up your home.

All this is to help keep up the value of your homes in the village and to keep the village beautiful for all residents and visitors alike.

After November 3<sup>rd</sup>. We would request that all residents' political signs be removed out of courtesy to one another for continued peaceful enjoyment of the community.

### REMINDERS:

**Rent Checks:** (and miscellaneous paperwork for the office) put into the black mailbox at the front (west) door to the right of the steps. This box is for Office In-Coming mail only – DO NOT PUT OUTGOING MAIL HERE

**Sales**: We encourage you to make an appointment. You can call the office at (863) 494-5669 or Ted at (863) 266-8729

Other Office Matters: Please call to make an appointment.

All visits to the office require a mask and that you stand back the 6' from the desk as shown on the floor markings.

**TRASH** – New regulations from the Desoto Landfill Waste Department: All Trash must be bagged, including trash in a container with a lid **must be bagged**. Please do not fill a bag so full the trash collectors cannot lift it to put into the truck. We do not want to get anyone injured. Large items, old flooring, appliances, electronics, (not a complete list) cannot be put out for trash pickup. You, or your contractor(s) are responsible for getting these item(s) to the landfill. You can find the Holiday Trash pickup Schedule at the Post Office Bulletin Board.

**WATER TURN ON/OFF** – Requests to TURN-ON/OFF water need be during business hours, Monday through Friday (8:00AM thru 3:00PM) **and** you must have an authorized representative (or be there yourself) at the house at the time water is turned on, when requesting off, make sure you have shut down water sources including the Water Heater.

**RENT LETTERS** went out the end of September. If you need an additional copy, please contact the office.

<u>Park Inspections</u> are done every few months to check the status of the properties in the park. When a home shows the need for some attention, whether it is weeds in a planter, or power washing parts or all of the home or shed, the office will make a courtesy call to the home owner first to inform them. If the number does not work or I do not receive a voicemail to leave a message then I will send out a post card to inform the home owner. Overall, we would like to greatly thank the vast majority of homes for their continued maintenance efforts.

As a reminder, please take a walk around the perimeter of your home occasionally and look for things to be addressed, like animals digging, or skirting issues weeds or house washing. If you have a homebound neighbor, or a neighbor that hasn't arrived yet, please consider walking their home and notifying them to help them.

Keep in mind that the current rate of \$500.00 has been held for the past 2 years and also includes the 7% sales tax.

Please see any of the commissioners who are posted in the clubhouse, to purchase your 2021 membership. Bag tags need to be placed on your golf bag by Jan 1, 2021. 
### MONDAY LADIES AND WEDNES-DAY MIXED LEAGUES

The leagues will begin the week of Nov. 16th. If you played in either league last year and we do not hear from you by Nov 8th, we will assume you are not playing this season.






