WELCOME HOME

FIRST, we want to say THANK YOU to everyone for your patience, understanding and compliance during this past summer. 2020 has been an incomparable year so far with the Corona Virus.

As we tackled COVID-19 Pandemic this past summer we have all (residents and office) been introduced to and learned new habits/behaviors. In addition, I am very happy to say that we have all stayed generally healthy here in the park and kept up everyone's spirits during activities, limited as they were.

As residents return to Arcadia Village for the season, we highly encourage you to read the notices and guidelines posted at amenities, clubhouses, and bulletin boards. We do post updated signs as needed, as things are still very dynamic.

Florida Numbers have been slowly improving. To help with that trend, everyone needs to continue to do their part. Please make sure you bring your own wipes and hand sanitizer with you in the community, make sure you wipe down anything you use inside a clubhouse, or at an amenity - and leave it clean for your fellow residents. Remember to wipe everything BEFORE and AFTER use to greatly decrease your chances of contracting or spreading Covid-19.

VERY IMPORTANT GUIDELINES/REMINDERS:

1st & Most Important: 60+ is Known to be the VULNERABLE POPULATION based on all the information provided by the CDC, Health Department, State Guidelines, etc.

All residents and guests understand that visiting any community area outside of their home is completely at **Your Own Risk**.

6' (or more) social distance **and** masks strongly advised and encouraged

No gatherings larger than 10 people, and all gatherings must maintain 6' social distance, wear masks, and carry hand sanitizer with you. These guidelines are ultimately for your continued health and safety.

All users of any community area are responsible for supplying their own cleaner/sanitizer Before & After use. Extra precautions go a long way.

Other information to know:

- **Rent Checks:** (and miscellaneous paperwork for the office) can be put into the black mailbox at the front (west) door to the right of the steps. If you need to speak to the office, call and make an appointment. This is for our safety as well as yours.

This box is for Office In-Coming mail only – **DO NOT PUT OUTGOING MAIL HERE**

- **Sales:** We encourage you to make an appointment. You can call the office at (863) 494-5669 or Ted at (863) 266-8729
- **Other Office Matters:** Please call the office first to make an appointment.
All visits to the office require a mask to be worn and we ask that you stand back the 6' from the desk as shown on the floor markings.
We want to stay healthy - as well as keep you healthy too!
- Every neighbor should do their best to have another contact within the community to check in with as needed. We always encourage residents to continue to keep an eye on each other, before/during/after the pandemic. This is one of the many benefits to being in a community – take advantage of it and help where you can.

We ask all residents to review their Rules and Regulations yearly as a reminder. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to ask the office. To start off the season, we would like to remind you of the following:

- **RENTING YOUR HOME** – If you rent your home for a few weeks, few months, a season, the owner of home must contact the office informing us of your intent to rent. All Renters must complete an application and be approved. This includes previous renters that have an application on file with the office. Renters also need to register at the office for guest passes and a rental information packet upon arrival.
- **SELLING YOUR HOME** – Whether you are selling your home through the office sales department or on your own, the office needs to be notified that you are selling. Applicant's purchasing a home in Arcadia Village must complete an application and be approved **before** you complete a private sale.
- **TRASH** – New regulations from the Desoto Landfill Waste Department: All Trash must be bagged, including trash in a container with a lid must be bagged. Please do not fill a bag so full the trash collectors cannot lift it to put into the truck. We do not want to get anyone injured.

Large items, old flooring, appliances, electronics, (not a complete list) cannot be put out for trash pickup. You, or your contractor(s) are responsible for getting these item(s) to the landfill. You can find the Holiday Trash pickup Schedule at the Post Office Bulletin Board.

- **WATER TURN ON** – Requests to TURN-ON water need be during business hours, Monday through Friday (8:00AM thru 3:00PM) **and** you must have an authorized representative (or be there yourself) in the house at the time water is turned on.
- **OFFICE EMAIL REQUEST:**

We are inviting every resident to provide an email address to the office. To accomplish this, we ask you to please send an email to (arcadiavillagemgmt@yahoo.com) with your E-MAIL address where you would like community notifications. This is strictly for Arcadia Village Management to send informational notices affecting the community.

- **RENT LETTERS** went out the end of September. If you need an additional copy, please contact the office.
- **PALM TREE CUTTING** will tentatively take place the week of 10/19/2020, (weather & equipment dependent). The office will need to be notified if you would like us to trim the palm tree in your front yard at the rate of \$25.00. If you are having your tree cut by someone else, please make sure it is done prior to October 31, 2020. If we are not notified either way, we will trim your tree and a \$25 invoice will be sent to you.

Gate Access After Hours: Only one phone number (home or cellular) can be entered into the gate software program. After the office has entered it, you will be allowed to open the gate for visitors.

The Visitor dials your lot # (example 532) on the key pad at the gate. Your phone will ring. Once you verify the caller, Press 9 on your phone and the gate will open and the call will disconnect.

Please call the office with any questions or to give us your lot number and phone number that you would like programmed into the gate.
