Seasonal Reminders:

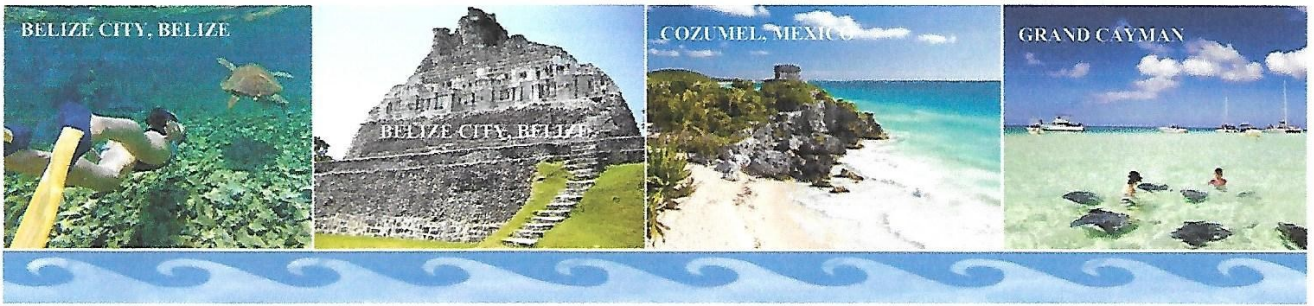
- Please pick-up after your pet. You do not want to look at, smell, or walk in it and neither does anyone else.

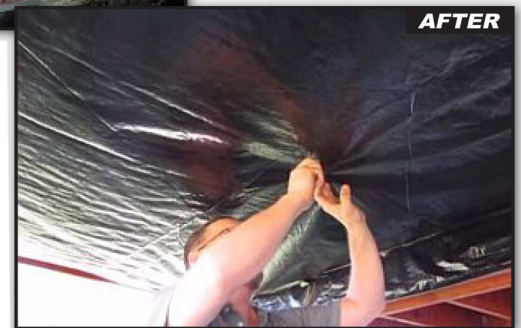

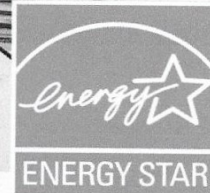

\$900.00/ home @ 2 Renters (New for 2021)

Keep in mind that the current rate of \$500.00 has been held for the past 2 years and also includes the 7% sales tax.

Please see any of the commissioners who are posted in the clubhouse, to purchase your 2021 membership. Bag tags need to be placed on your golf bag by Jan 1, 2021. All commissioners are also selling raffle tickets for a free membership. Tickets are 3 for \$5.00 and the drawing will be held on Saturday December 5th.

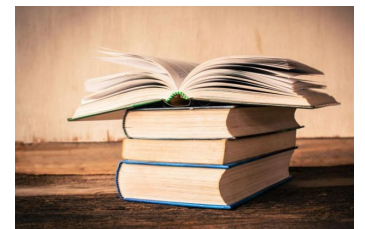

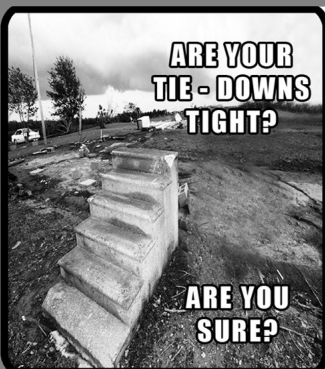

Cyndy's Sip and Paint class

On Wednesday December 9th we will be painting the Holiday Sign "JOY". This is a 3"x31" white painted wood board and a sand dollar which will be used for the "O". We will be painting the rest of the sign. The session will be from 2 - 4pm at the Cantina.

On Sunday December 27th we will paint the Red Blossom Sunset" on an 11"x14" stretched canvas. It will be an afternoon of entertainment, fun, painting and laughing with friends. You do NOT need painting experience or to be creative to join in the fun to paint in this class. We will instruct you step by step to create your own masterpiece.

Because of COVID-19 we will be practicing social distancing, with 2 people per table. Masks are required when entering the building and walking around, each person will have their own supplies consisting of an easel, brushes, paint pallet and aprons. All our supplies are cleaned and sanitized after every event.

The cost of each seat will be \$20. That will be collected at the door on the day of the event. Acrylic paint is quick drying, so you can take your painting and glasses home at the end of the class. We will have everything needed for each session. We do all the setup, cleaning, and tear down. All you will need to do is sign up, show up, and bring your favorite beverage.

Please register in advance by signing the sheet at the Cantina or Siesta Bulletin board or you can send me a text at 616-520-1456, Registering in advance insures we will have enough set ups for each painter when you arrive, however we will carry a few extras for those last-minute change of plans or guests that were not able to register ahead of time. Arrive a few minutes early so we can start on time. and you can get your seats by your friends.
