GATES – Come by or call the office to have your phone number put into the Gate program. This allows you to let yourself or someone into the park when Gate is down.

WATER ON/OFF – Requests to TURN-ON/OFF water should be called into the office and will be done during business hours, Mon - Fri (8:00AM thru 3:00PM). Resident is responsible to have an authorized representative (or be on site yourself) at the time water is turned on/off. When you call to request water turn off, make sure you have shut down water sources including the Water Heater.

PARK PROPERTY TREES & RV STORAGE

The bushes and trees that we planted in the RV Storage Area are maintained by the Arcadia Village maintenance department. If you have a concern, questions or other need with any of the RV lots, area or landscaping, call and talk to the office for assistance. Do Not take it upon yourself to maintain without asking.

DILIGENCE & CONSISTENCY = SAFETY & HEALTHY

COVID-19 Virus & Influenza FLU are still prevalent in the USA & Florida. Please, if you travel, plane, train, automobile, or down the street, make sure you are masked, gloved, sanitized and distancing. When you arrive home in the village, think about the trip and if you think you could have been exposed. ARCADIA VILLAGE SECURITY AND NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH MONTHLY ARTICLE

February Topic: Front and Rear Gate - Options for Entry

If the gates are closed, the following are your options:

Option #1: If you have an Arcadia Village **KEY FOB** (clicker), and it is registered at the office, you only have to click and the gate should open, if it doesn't, please get with Sylvia on the next business day at the office to get it registered into the computer. If you don't have a Key fob, they are for sale at the office, see Sylvia.

Option #2: "ONLY ON FRONT GATE" If you have a **CARD FOB**, simply go up to the key pad at the gate and place it on the card reader, the gate should open, if it does not, then you will need to see Sylvia on the next business day to get the card programmed into the computer. Cards are also available at the office, see Sylvia.

Option #3: Have your cell or home phone programmed to your Lot # by Sylvia at the office, then when you get to the gate, you simple put your lot number into the key pad and hit (Call) button, the computer will call your phone and you can hit the number **9** on your phone, and it will open the gate you are at. This must be programmed into the computer, so see Sylvia. This is also helpful for visitors or vendors coming in after the gates are closed, they just put in your lot number on the key pad and hit (Call) button at the gate, the computer will call the programmed phone number, you will be able to

talk to the person at the gate, and if you want to let them in, you just hit the number **9** on your phone, and the gate will open. If you don't know the person calling hit the **#** symbol on the phone, and it will disconnect and deny entry. Remember to program the gates into your phone so that you know who is calling you:

Front Gate: 863-494-0738

Back Gate: 863-263-4314

Option #4: (This to be used when the above doesn't get you in) When you get to the gate, simply dial security at **999** on the key pad and hit the (Call) button - you will be connected to Joe Enderby (Security Manager at Arcadia Village), identify yourself and what lot # you are, and he can open the gate remotely.

Please "**DO NOT**" force the gate by **LIFTING OR PUSHING ON THE ARMS**, as these gates are monitored by video camera systems, and you will be held accountable for any damages you cause to the gates.

As always, please help us help you by remembering we are a community and looking out for each other is the only way we can keep safe and sound in Arcadia Village.

VALENTINES DAY COOKIE RECIPE

Original recipe yields 17 servings

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup butter
- 1 ½ cups confectioners' sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ½ teaspoon almond extract (Optional)
- 2 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon cream of tartar

Directions

In a large bowl, cream together butter and confectioners' sugar. Beat in egg, vanilla and almond extract. Mix well. In a medium bowl, stir together flour, baking soda and cream of tartar; blend into the butter mixture. Divide dough into thirds and shape into balls.

Working with 1/3 of dough at a time, roll out dough into desired thickness on a lightly floured surface. For each heart sandwich cookie, cut out 2 3-inch hearts. Cut out the center of ONE of the 3-inch hearts with the 1 1/2-inch cutter.

Place each piece separately on an ungreased cookie sheet, 1 - 2 inches apart. Bake in a preheated, 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) oven until lightly browned (7-8 minutes for 1/4 inch thick cookies). Cool completely on wire rack. Frost bottom cookie with Pink Valentine Frosting and place an open centered cookie on top to form the sandwich. Also frost the small 1 1/2 inch hearts and serve as separate cookies.

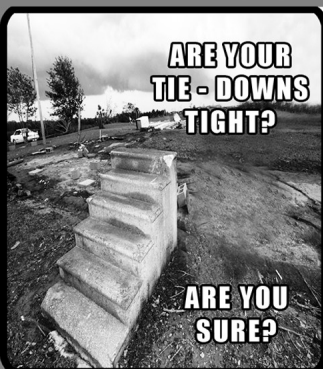

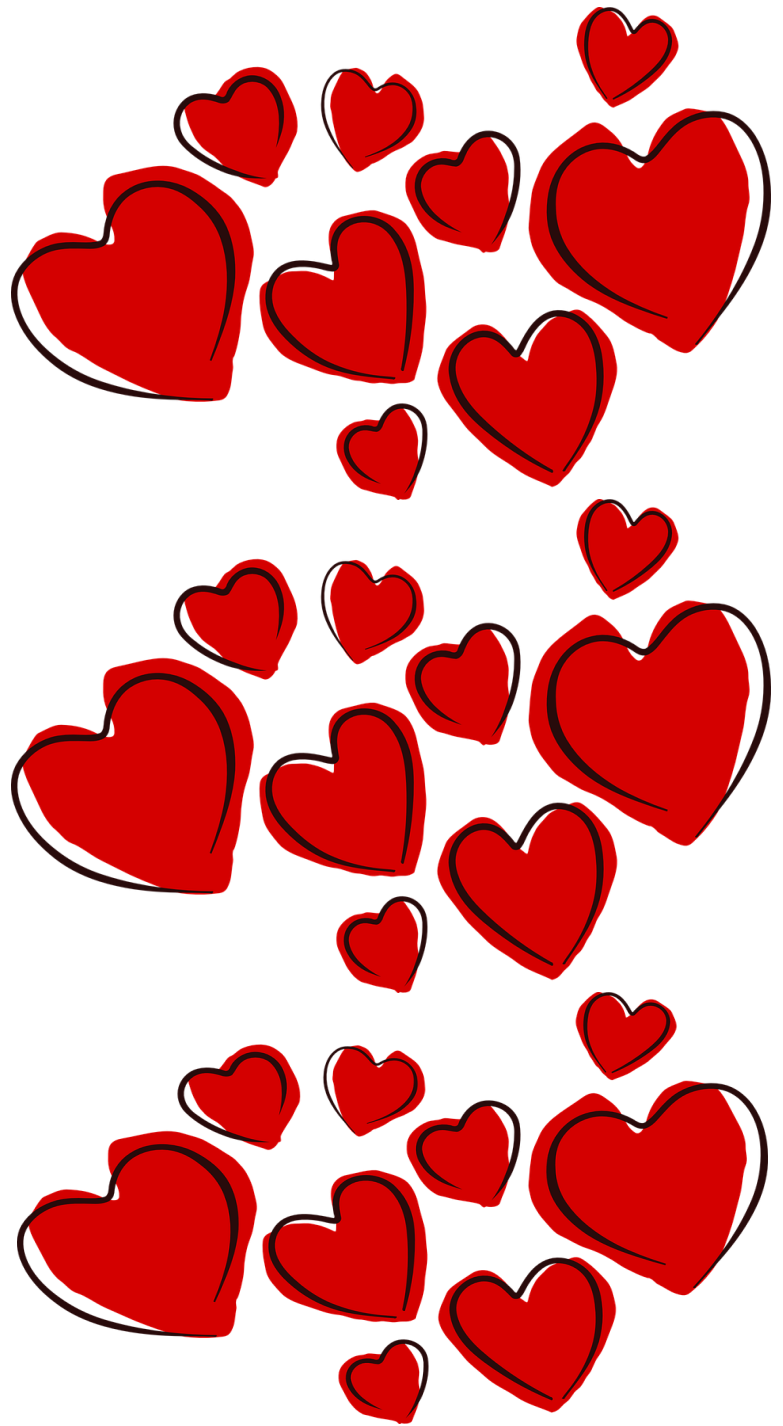

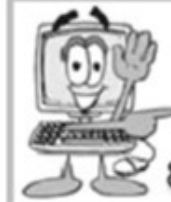
