## HOA MEETINGS AND UPDATES

Everyone is invited and welcome. Your concerns should be brought in writing to be presented at the homeowner comment section of the meeting. HOA meetings will be held the first Tuesday of each month.

### HOA News Update This is very important !!!

#### EXPLANATION OF THE POSTPONEMENT OF THE ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Membership Meeting had to be postponed on 12/14/2021 because of the lack of members attending or submitting a Proxy. We are required to have 30% of the members present or have Proxy's if members can't attend. Although we had over 60 members in attendance, we ended up short of the required amount needed for a quorum.

### The meeting has now been moved to January 18, 2022.

According to the guidelines, this Annual Meeting is the only meeting that requires at least 30% of the members to be present, or a Proxy submitted in place of attending. This meeting also comes with a substantial cost. It is required that if a member does not sign a waiver, the Board is required to send a letter to each household advising them of the Annual Meeting. This year, this cost us around \$50.00 for this mailing.

So, please mark this **January 18, 2022**, date in your events calendar. If you cannot attend, make sure you sign and submit a Proxy, which counts as attending the meeting. If you need a Proxy, there is one on page 5 (next page) that you may use or let us know, we will make sure you get one.

#### MEMBERSHIP QUESTIONS

To clear up some confusion about membership. If you paid your \$10.00 dues in 2019, you overpaid by \$5.00 because the bylaws that were in place were found to be invalid. We had to revert to the 2016 bylaws, therefore dues remained at \$5.00 annually. There was an overpayment of \$5.00 paid for the 2020 membership. In 2021 the Board suspended dues for 2021 because of Covid restrictions. HOA 2022 Dues of \$5.00 are due now. **If you are new to the Village or not a current member and want to become one, there is a one-time \$5.00 Registration fee in addition to the \$5.00 yearly dues, The registration is a one time fee.**

For the January 18<sup>th</sup> meeting, all current 2021 and new 2022 members (new to the Village in 2020 or 2021) can participate.

Please keep in mind that you are required to use a tee off the tee boxes. We have just completed over seeding both the front and back nine and really want the course to remain in great condition. We have also made improvements to #13 White tee box. Please fix your divots and ball marks. Very frustrating when we see divots not being repaired. Sand boxes are located close by so please fill that area. White lines have also been painted in front of the greens to keep carts away from greens.

If you have been issued a Handicap label ( Severely Handicap) You must still apply a 90 Deg rule to the fairways when playing golf. You cannot just drive down the middle of the fairways.

## ARCADIA VILLAGE SECURITY AND NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH MONTHLY ARTICLE FOR JANUARY 2022

Topic: **Walking/Running, Riding Bicycles and Golf Carts in Arcadia Village**

### **Walking/Running:**

While walking/running on the streets within Arcadia Village, every walker should be on the left side of the road facing traffic. This enables the walker/runner to see the traffic that is coming, and gives you time to get out of the way. If you walk with the traffic, you cannot see the vehicle coming up behind you, and with electric cars and golf carts that are extremely quiet, you do not have any reaction time to get out of the way. Stay to the left facing the traffic, and if you are walking/running in poor visibility or at night, please wear a reflective or high visibility clothing or vest, and have a flashlight.

### **Bicycling:**

While bicycling on the streets within Arcadia Village, every cyclist should be riding on the right side of the road with the traffic, stay to the side of the road, use hand signals for making turns and stopping. Please stop at all stop signs and obey all traffic laws, as you are considered a vehicle. Make sure your bicycle has reflectors both front (white) and back (red), it is a good idea to have a rear viewing mirror also. If you are going to ride at night or in poor visibility, please make sure your bicycle is equipped with a white light in front and a red light in the rear, (strobe lights work well). Remember be as visible as possible to all the other vehicles and walkers on the streets, and be courteous to all the people walking in the village.

### **Golf Carts:**

The use of golf carts in Arcadia Village are widely used by our residents. Remember golf carts are a vehicle and must obey all traffic laws. If you use a golf cart at night, it must have working lights on, white in the front and red in the back. If it doesn't have lights for at night then don't drive it - (WALK). All golf carts must either use hand signals or electric turn/stop signals while operating in the village.

Some correlate the black-eyed peas shape to coins (other traditions include eating 12 peas on New Year's—one for each month—for good luck), while the greens signify money and cornbread stands for gold.

### NEW YEAR'S HOPPIN' JOHN BY STEPHANIE BUTLER – HISTORY SITE

**Start to finish: 1 hour      Servings: 10**

- 2 tablespoons olive oil**
- 1 cup red onion, chopped**
- 1/2 cup celery, chopped**
- 1 cup red bell pepper, chopped**
- 2 jalapeños, stemmed and deseeded, chopped**
- 1 tablespoon chopped garlic**
- 2 smoked turkey thighs, skin removed**
- 1 pound black-eyed peas, soaked overnight and rinsed**
- 1 quart low-sodium chicken stock**
- 1 bay leaf**
- 3 sprigs fresh thyme (or 1 teaspoon dried thyme)**
- 1 teaspoon salt**
- Salt, black pepper and cayenne to taste**
- 1 cup green onion, chopped**
- 4 cups freshly steamed white rice**

Heat the olive oil over medium-high heat in large soup pot or Dutch oven. Add the onion, celery, bell pepper, jalapeños and garlic, and cook until opaque and lightly browned, about 8 minutes. Add the turkey thighs, peas, chicken stock, bay leaf, thyme and a teaspoon of salt. Simmer for 40 minutes, or until peas are creamy and tender. If liquid evaporates, add more stock or water. Adjust seasonings, and garnish with green onions. Serve hot over rice

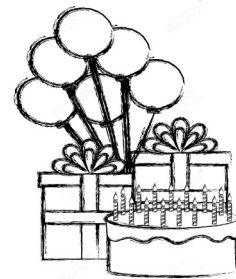

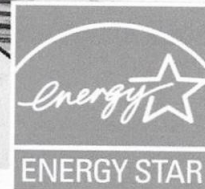

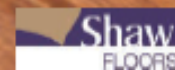
