Make sure you have contacted your home maintenance person to confirm they have you on schedule for upcoming season.

Make sure your RV Space is well marked as shown and your spot is kept trimmed through-out the upcoming summer

### **ALL RESIDENTS INFORMATION:**

Please contact the office for any property modifications, (pavers, concrete, enclosures, other major change) Office needs to review items of importance about property, water lines and such before any work begins.

Cleaning up after your pet is a Rule! Pets are not allowed in the clubhouse, pools or recreational areas, except in emergencies (as specified by management), or service animals

**INSPECTIONS** – The office will be driving through the park in the next couple of months checking homes, clean, weeds, planters, etc. Please make sure your maintenance is up to date. ### **Attention all residents of Arcadia Village.**

It is time again to form a Rent Negating Committee. In 2018 the previous committee negotiated for three (3) years which will end at the end of this year.

There are three main forms of lease agreements within the community. The legacy lifetime lease that was signed prior to the current owners. These agreements are a set rate and not negotiable. The CPI (Consumer Price Index) lease are only available to residents that purchase a new home. These leases are not negotiable either. This leaves the third lease agreement which is the majority of the homeowners.

The HOA represents the third group of homeowners in case the owner decides to sell, and also negotiate rent increases. Florida statute 723 requires the HOA to obtain consent from the majority of the affected homeowners in writing.

Florida statute 723 gives the HOA a seat at the negotiation table. The HOA does need to approve the rent agreement this is true, however we have very little say in the actual rent increase. The reason the HOA does meet with the owners is to ensure the rent increase is reasonable and to make sure there are no reduction in services or utilities.

If you have not given the HOA signed consent for them to represent you, please do so. There are forms available on the HOA board in the Cantina Clubhouse or from myself or Sharon Lindsay.

# ARCADIA VILLAGE SECURITY AND NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH MONTHLY ARTICLE

## March Topics:

Time change March 14th - Check and replace smoke detector batteries

Exterior Light on your Planter or house

Reflective Walking Vest at night and during poor visibility - for walkers and bicycle riders

**Time change on March 14th** - Spring ahead (1) hour - and time to check and replace the 9 volt batteries in your smoke detectors that have them. If your smoke detectors have the lithium batteries then this does not apply.

**Exterior Light on the front of your house.** ( on most planters): Please leave your exterior light on 24/7 as this not only helps with lighting up the neighborhood streets for people walking at night, but also illuminates your house number in case of an emergency for EMS, Fire and Sherriff vehicles to locate your house. If you replace the bulb with a new LED light, the cost to run it is next to nothing and they last for more than 10 years. If your light doesn't have the sensor for Dusk to Dawn only, you can replace the bulb with a LED that has the Dusk to Dawn sensor in it for under \$10.00 at Lowe's or most hardware stores. If you have questions contact Joe Enderby or Joe Wentworth. But please leave the exterior light on for safety.

## **Walking reflective vest for people walking or riding bicycles at night or in low visibility:**

We want to encourage people to buy and wear the reflective high visibility vests for wear at night and early morning to make you more visible to drivers. The vest can be procured on Amazon, at Walmart and most department stores for around \$8.00, an investment that is well worth it. I would look for one that has reflective tape and is made of material that is either high visibility green or orange material. The more visible you are the less chance of someone not seeing you and you have an

accident, remember the vehicle is a lot bigger and will win every time. All accidents are preventable, and we (residents) don't bounce back as well as we get older. This is an investment that may save your life. I (Joe Wentworth) wear my vest when I walk in the morning when it is foggy and at night in the dark. Take a flashlight with you. The more visibility the better (BE SEEN).

A great big THANK YOU to the 20+ blood donors from our village who donated in January. You are eligible to donate on March 24th when the Bloodmobile will be back for our blood donations. The bus will be on the tennis court side of Cantina Clubhouse. Have you considered donating double red blood cells? I give doubles because I have had instances when giving singles I have passed out because of dehydration. When I give doubles, I have no problems because they take only the red blood cells and return the fluid to me. Doubles permit a patient to receive two pints from

the same donor. (Better for cancer patients.) The bus will be available for collecting whole blood or if you prefer double red blood cells. (It can hold 8 people, but CDC rules limit the bus to four.) Sign up in Cantina on the bulletin board for an appointment. CDC precautions are followed.

The blood that we donate is used by a local hospital to save lives. You never know when you or a loved one will need this precious gift. Blood supply is critically low. The CONCIERGE bus will come on Friday March 26 at 11:00 AM. That little bus holds only one or two donors at a time.

You will receive free tests of cholesterol, blood type, blood pressure, temperature, pulse, Covid 19 antibodies and iron count (hemoglobin). You will be given a donor ID number to go on line where you can receive your results and utilize a donor rewards program which will tell you how to spend points earned toward gifts (free shipping) for your donations.

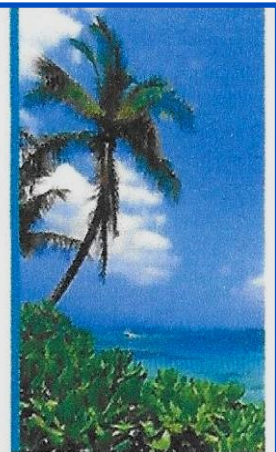
