CDC / Vaccines / Masks / Washing Hands

Many here in the park have been able to get their COVID Shot. NOT every person is allowed to get the shot for medical or other reason. Please be understanding of someone whether they tell you why or keep it a private reason.

We review and post updated guidelines every couple of months that reflect the CDC and State of Florida guidelines. Any events planned at either Community Clubhouse or Amenity location must be open to all residents. If a resident would like to host an event, and limit it for only those who have had the vaccine or for other reason(s), then the event must be held at their own private home.

Residents Heading out of town:

Please make sure you have returned all (Yellow) guest passes to the office.

Call office in advance to schedule your water shut-off between 8:30a – 3:30p, remember to turn off your water heater and set you're AC & Humidistat.

Find a trustworthy neighbor to keep an eye on your home and/or has a key to your home to let in service people as needed.

Make sure your RV Space is well marked and your spot is kept trimmed through-out the year.

All Residents information:

Rules and Regulations Paragraph 5, please re-read and let's all have a nice summer.

Rules and Regulations Paragraph 12 clearly states:

“Hand watering” only is permitted, during reasonable daylight hours. Sprinklers are only allowed with a dated note from the office for special circumstances. Any questions on this rule please call the office.

Rules and Regulations Paragraph 25 clearly states:

The resident owner is required to clean up after his pet has defecated. Please help keep the park enjoyable.

New Signs will be placed around the Mail Stations and the Maintenance Area. Please DO NOT walk any pets in and around these areas

Please contact the office for any property modifications, (pavers, concrete, enclosures, posts, other major change)

Office needs to review items of importance about property, utility lines and other before any work begins.

Golf Carts and responsible and courtesy driving is recommended and requested.
