





#### IT'S GRILLING SEASON

I really enjoy grilled vegetables. They get cooked just to the right doneness for each person, You want char on your vegetables leave on longer, you want crunchy vegetables take off sooner, the beauty is there no right or wrong way to grill vegetables, you get to have them your way. The other part I really enjoy is that I get to choose my vegetables. Some of the best grilling vegetables are: Zucchini, Squash, Onions, Bell peppers, Mushrooms, Corn on the Cob large or cut up small and added to a skewer, Cauliflower, Broccoli, Baby Tomatoes to name a few and then there are of course others that can be put on a sheet on the grill like asparagus.

I like to cut up vegetables into a large dish and then let each person create their own skewer with what vegetables they like. To marinate or not marinate the vegetables ahead of time? I like to marinate my vegetables a few hours or night before the BBQ. Or make a special butter sauces to put on the vegetable when come off the grill.


Marinade could be: a couple tablespoons of olive oil, some balsamic or vinegar flavor of choice, chopped or smashed garlic or shallots, then some herbs and spices, Tarragon, Salt, Pepper, Thyme, Basil, Oregano, cilantro or any combo you want to put together of spices working together to make you happy. Or Grill vegetables and put some compound butter sauce on. Compound Butters

<u>Lemon Dill – Ingredients – for Bright delightful taste to food</u> 1/2 cup butter 1 stick, at room, temperature, 1 lemon zested, plus juice of half the lemon, 1 tablespoon fresh dill chopped, pinch of kosher salt.

<u>Spicy Buffalo – Ingredients – for the buffalo kick to vegetables</u> 1/2 cup butter (1 stick), at room temperature, 2 ounces blue cheese, crumbled, 1 tablespoon Frank's Red Hot Sauce or other vinegar based hot sauce, 1 tablespoon chopped chives.

<u>Cinnamon and Chipotle Chili – Ingredients – for the Mexican inspired taste</u> ½ cup 1 stick, at room temperature, 1 Tsp Orange Zest, ¾ Tsp Cinnamon, ¼ Tsp Chipotle chili powder, ¼ Tsp Chili powder, pinch salt

How To: Mix the ingredients in a small bowl until well combined. Lay out a large piece of plastic wrap on a clean counter. Spoon the butter mixture onto the bottom third of plastic wrap, then roll into a log. Refrigerate for one hour, or until firm.


