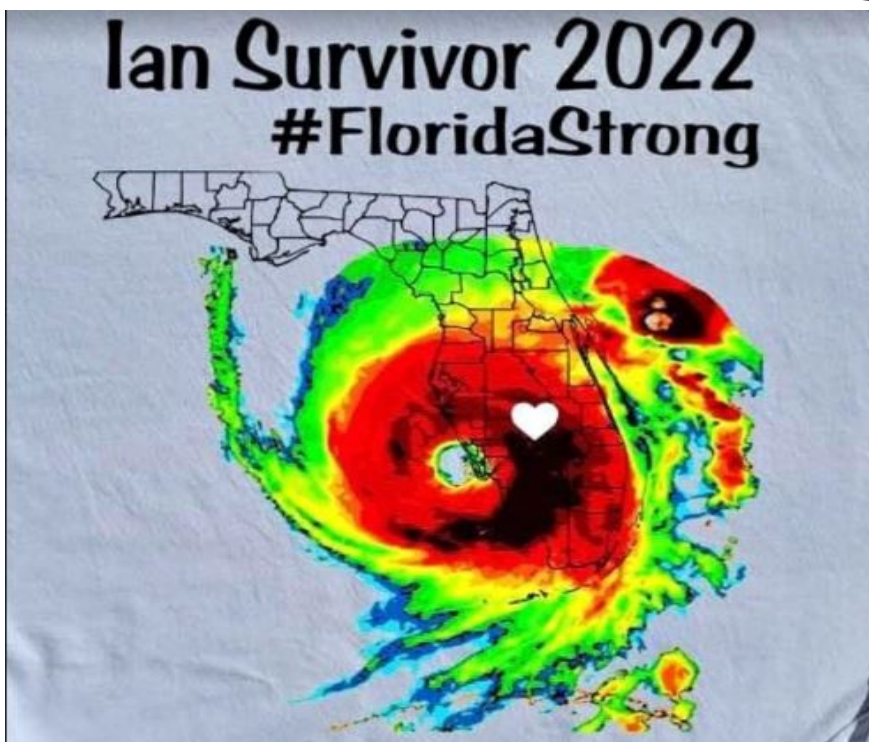

MORE FROM THE OFFICE

As residents return to Arcadia Village for the season, we highly encourage you to read the notices and guidelines posted at amenities, clubhouses, and bulletin boards and in the newsletter to stay up to date.

- **Tree Trimming:** will be done a little later this year. We are still working on the date.
- **Golf Carts:** Florida State Rules state that anyone driving a golf cart must have an ID card or possess a valid driver's license. Children must be in the presence of an adult (18+) when in a golf cart. Please remember this rule is in place for everyone's safety.
- **Speeding:** The Speed Limit in Arcadia Village is (15) miles per hour. This includes golf carts, cars, trucks, and all other motorized vehicles. Please follow this Rule.

OFFICE NEWS CONTINUED:

Please when you walk your animal friends, clean up after your pet, it is a Park Rule. Carry a couple bags with you. This includes the front of park open area and the back open phase of park.

Other information to know:

WATER TURN ON – Requests to TURN-ON or OFF water need be during business hours of, Monday through Friday (8:00AM thru 3:00PM) **and** you must have an authorized representative (or be there yourself) in the house at the time water is turned on.

RENTING YOUR HOME – If you rent your home for a few weeks, few months, or a season, the owner of the home must contact the office letting Sylvia know you're renting, they need to either have an application on file or fill one out. Renters need to register at the office for guest passes and a rental information packet upon arrival.

SELLING YOUR HOME – We encourage you to make an appointment. You can call Robin at (863) 303-3590 or the office at (863) 494-5669

TRASH – You can find the Holiday Trash pickup Schedule at the Mail Stations, Bulletin Boards and inside of each newsletter.

Desoto Landfill Waste Department guidelines: All Trash must be bagged, including trash in a container with a lid must be bagged. Please do not fill a bag so full the trash collectors cannot lift it to put into the truck. Doggie pickup bags need to be in larger regular size trash bags. Our maintenance will not take small

doggie pick-up bags out of a trash can.

Large items, old flooring, appliances, electronics, (not a complete list) cannot be put out for trash pickup. You, or your contractor(s), are responsible for getting these item(s) to the Desoto landfill. Boxes can be flattened and put next to your trash.

FROM THE GOLF COMMISSION:

The Arcadia Village Golf Commission is glad to be a part of a community where neighbor helps neighbor. We are all sorry for those who have lost so much because of Hurricane Ian.

The golf course, as you all saw, had much debris strewn about and many trees down. After cleaning up debris and removing 13 trees, the front nine is now open. We sincerely hope that our members will get out, have some fun, and play some golf. More damage was sustained on the back nine. We are in the process of getting that cleaned up. It will open as soon as possible. Thank you for your patience.



We have met with management and now have the fee set for 2023. We had hoped for no increase, but expenses continue to rise, so we have settled on \$620. That works out to be \$1.67 a month increase.

Rental Memberships will be as follows:

6 Months \$930.00 per house for 2 residents

1 Month trial membership is \$465.00 per house for 2 residents.

Memberships will go on sale at the Cantina in November. The days and times will be posted. Watch the golf bulletin board for the schedules. As in the past, you may also purchase from any Golf Commissioner.

The smells of Thanksgiving include cranberry so this month I'm sharing a fun, easy and aromatic dish for your holiday table.

Cranberry & Brie Pull Apart Bread Easy

– Cook time 20-25 min – Prep time 10-min

1 Large Sourdough Bread Loaf –or– 2 smaller sized loafs

½ Cup un-salted butter room temp

16oz wheel of Brie cubed

1 Tsp fresh or dried Thyme

1 Tsp fresh or dried Rosemary

¼ Tsp Salt (optional) ¼ Cup craisins

1 Can Ocean Spray whole cranberry sauce

Additional fresh thyme for garnish



Preheat Oven 350°F

Slice bread into a grid fashion (Careful not to slice all the way through the bottom)

In a small bowl combine butter, thyme, rosemary and salt and stir to combine.

Place bread in a foil lined baking sheet and brush with butter mixture. Stuff each sliced area with cubes of cut up brie, then spoon in cranberry sauce and sprinkle top with craisins.

Wrap the bread in foil and bake approximately 20-minutes.

Remove Foil and continue to bake (brown) another 5-10 minutes.

Garnish with additional thyme if desired.

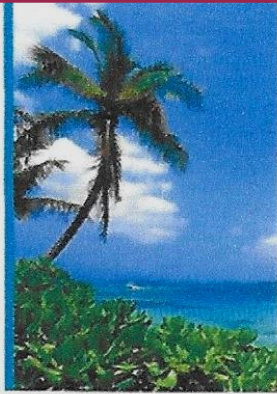

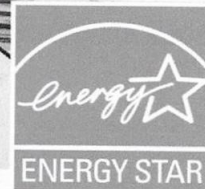

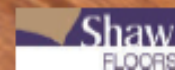
