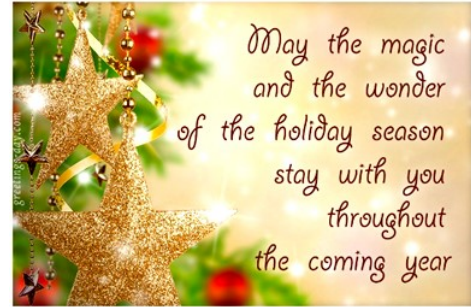

We all weathered Ian and then Nicole very well. Arcadia Villagers came together amazingly well helping neighbors while staying calm. Thank you everyone!

Some helpful Hurricane Cleanup information.

Ask your Contractors with a fully loaded truck to use the appropriate Gate Entrance: Lots 1-199 use Front Gate, Lots 407-809 use Back Gate. Have the Contractor dial your house number to have the Gate Opened. (Contact the office for information to open the gate) No fully loaded delivery or contractor trucks should cross the bridge.

The Park will not pick-up anymore construction or home debris. All residents will need to get their home debris to the landfill and make sure all contractors know that they are required to take away their debris from the park.

For Aluminum debris contact the office for disposal options.

Do Not Throw wood or other household debris in the back lot or burn piles. Our burn permit does not allow us to burn anything except vegetation brush.

Home Demolition – Please call and let the office know as soon as possible. We require a copy of the permit for demolition. There are other guidelines, please call the office for a complete review of what's expected / required.

### Seasonal Reminders:

- Remember to watch the Mail Station Bulletin Boards for office news updates
- Palm Tree trimming this year will be sometime in December as it stands right now. Please let the office know if you want your tree trimmed.
- Amid Flu & Covid season we would like to remind everyone to remain attentive in their care. Sanitize and keep a social distance when attending events.

## OFFICE NEWS CONTINUED:



PLEASE...Speed Limit in the Arcadia Village Park is (15-MPH) no exceptions! Resident bikers & bikers with friends are allowed to ride through park at the Park Speed Limit (15-MPH). If bikers use the back gate or front gate after hours, bring your clicker, Do Not Push/Pull or Lift or break the gate.

- Did you know that both Gates have cameras? Please do not Push Pull or otherwise try to open gates without a clicker. Call the house number of the resident for access.
- RV Parking in front of your house is a MAXIMUM of 2 Days only to Load or Un-Load. NO Car, Trailer or RV parking in empty lots, we cannot mow or otherwise maintain the property properly – and you risk doing major damage to underground utilities, especially when the ground is saturated. Street Parking is 4 hour parking limit, if you need longer, you should park at a Club House with your parking permit on your dash for identification.
- Please make sure you have scheduled your power wash and gutter cleaning and weeding. Home inspections will resume once hurricane recovery (x2) is under control.
- Please take a look at your RV Lot and clean up as needed.
- A few resident lot number signs have blown away. Please replace your identification at your earliest convenience. Thank you.
- Club House Events: Residents and Event coordinators that have a events, dance, dinner, food, etc...., are to make sure all trash is bagged, tied and removed to the dumpster **outside** the clubhouse. (you will find dumpster outside kitchen door next to Gym) Events are also responsible for wiping down tables, floors, kitchens as used and if you move furniture around during an event you are to move it back to the way it was before your event.

### Renting Your Home:

Please remember that if you are renting your home for any length of time, the home owner needs to tell the office and the renters need to check in with the front office when they arrive to get rental passes and renter guidelines. This includes all repeat renters.

### Selling Your Home:

Contact Robin Ivanssek in the Arcadia Village office for an appointment to discuss selling your home. Regardless if you list your home with us or sell FSBO, you **must** contact the office and let us know - so we can associate any residency applications received for your lot.

## Winter Time Pool - Q&A 10/2022

### WHAT TEMPERATURE DO YOU KEEP THE POOL & SPA

Pool 86° to 88° degrees (will vary depending)  
Spa 102° to 104° degrees (outside temperatures)

### WHEN DO YOU USE THE POOL COVER

Due to Florida Health Department regulations we cannot have a vinyl pool cover. We are now using a liquid pool cover. It will help on cold nights to hold the heat. There will be a difference in the length of time that it takes for the water to get back to scheduled temperature after a cold spell

### Why is the Spa and Pool Cold

In the winter, anytime the average air temperature (high and low) is 65°F or higher, your heat pump will work to expectations.

- On average, a heat pump usually requires between 24 and 72 hours to heat a swimming pool by 20° and between 45 and 70 minutes to heat a spa by 20°.
- This means if the outside temperature goes down into the 30's, and two days later rises back up to 70's it could take from 4 hours to 2 + days to heat back to the average daily temperature.  
It is based on daily & nightly low and high temperatures.

## CHRISTMAS MORNING DELIGHT From Sylvia Clay

### BAKED FRENCH TOAST

EASY and make the night before for a stress free holiday morning with family, wake up in the morning, throw in the oven, start the coffee or tea pot and enjoy your morning with family. Eat when timer goes off.

I like to change up the bread from time to time. Sometimes I will use Raisin Bread, Challah Bread, Panettone or a nut bread. Make sure you slice into thick slices.

Depending on the spice in the bread you will modify the spice in the French toast mixture.

- 1) First dry out the bread slices
- 2) Then make the Custard
- 3) Dip bread in the custard
- 4) Line a buttered baking pan with dipped bread slices in a shingle format
- 5) Pour remaining custard over slices of bread.
- 6) Cover with Foil and let sit 30 min or overnight in the fridge if prepping the night before. BAKE: 350° for 30-MIN. Remove foil, sprinkle cinnamon sugar over top and bake 10 min or until tops of bread pieces show brown and beginning to crust up.

#### CUSTARD

1 large day old bread loaf like brioche, challah, crusty sourdough or French bread

6 whole eggs

1 cup whole milk

1/2 cup heavy whipping cream

2 tablespoons real maple syrup

1 tablespoon vanilla extract

3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/8 teaspoon ground cardamom

1/8 teaspoon fresh grated nutmeg

1/8 teaspoon salt (optional)

2 tablespoons butter plus more for greasing pan

Optional toppings: Maple syrup, honey, powdered sugar and fresh berries

#### CINNAMON SUGAR TOPPING

1 tablespoon granulated sugar

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

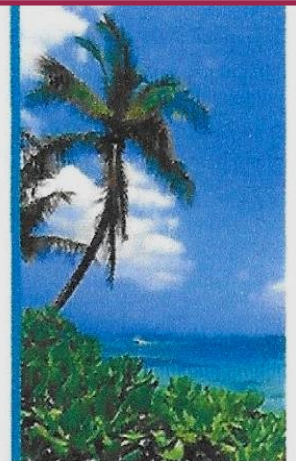

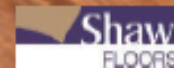
