Make sure your spot is clearly marked, I have been known to give away a spot that is vacant and not marked in error. If you do not need your spot let the office know. Each spot is on a map with a name and lot number. Do not park in an empty spot not assigned to your lot number please!
- ⇒ **Remember:** Put away all outside items that could fly away in a storm.
- ⇒ **Remember:** Water Shut-Off: Notify the office in advance between 8 am – 3 pm Monday thru Friday. Don't forget to turn off your water heater and set your AC & Humidistat.
- ⇒ **Reminder:** Replace outside bulbs, they should last through the summer.
- ⇒ **Remember:** UPDATE office with Phone Number and address so you can be reached in case there is an immediate need for us to get in touch with you.
- ⇒ **Reminder:** Tree trimming is around October. Let the office know if you want your tree trimmed before you leave for the summer

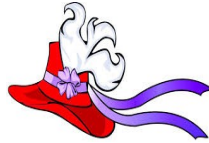

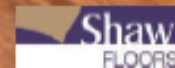

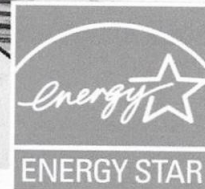
