WELCOME HOME RESIDENTS

The last year Arcadia Village has had a flurry of new residents joining the Arcadia Village Park Family. Say hello to your new neighbors and invite them to join you in activities and events here in the park.

REMINDERS & UPDATES:

PALM TREE CUTTING will tentatively take place end of October every resident will need to contact the office and let us know if you would like us to trim the palm tree in your front yard at the rate of \$25.00. If you are having your tree cut by someone else, please make sure it is done prior to October 1st.

Anyone that is still waiting for Construction work on your home and if you have not been notified then we ask you to please contact the office with any time frames so we can update our inspection list. Thank you

Pools, clubhouses, shuffleboard, tennis, pickle ball and other activities and locations inside of the park are open to all residents in the village and their registered guests with the exception of the Golf course, which is only available to resident with membership.

You may use either pool or clubhouse (Cantina or Siesta), and there are no restrictions to building use or activity attendance other than what is requested by the particular activity posting.

All visitors should carry a (Yellow) visitor pass with them when visiting any public area of the village.

Visitors under 18 years of age must be with a resident or a visitor over the age of 18 carrying a visitor pass.

To schedule an event to be put on the calendar for either Siesta or Cantina Clubhouse contact the office.

WATER TURN ON – Requests to TURN-ON or OFF water need be during business hours of, Monday through Friday (8:00AM thru 3:00PM) and you must have an authorized representative (or be there yourself) in the house at the time water is turned on.

RENTING OR SELLING: *LET SYLVIA KNOW IN THE OFFICE. THE OFFICE CANNOT PROCESS ANY APPLICATION RECEIVED WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE CURRENT HOME OWNER.*

Renters need to register at the office for guest passes and a rental information packet upon arrival.

Other items to REMEMBER

- * Do NOT feed the wild animals, they are not pets and it is Florida State law statutes that feeding some wildlife is against the law.
- * The cows, they are privately owned, feeding them is against the law.
Thank you for your cooperation.
- * Pickup after your pet is a Park Rule
- * ALL pets must be on a leash when outside of their home. No pets are to be tied up outside of the home. No pet is to be left unattended outside of the home.
- * Please ask all deliveries or contractors during gate closed hours to call (**your house number**) residents have access to open the gate for their own deliveries and visitors. Security is for emergency gate access as needed. Contact the office for instructions or to be programmed into the gate.
- * Resident's please ask any large furniture or contractor deliveries that will be a heavy load to use the gate in the Front or Back of park respective to where you live. Thank you
- ◆ RV parking is allowed (2) days in front of house to Load and Unload. After 2 days you need to park in the RV lot and can only bring over for (4) hours at a time for working on/in your RV unit as needed.
- ◆ DO NOT Park in empty lots. It delays maintenance work from being done on lots as needed.

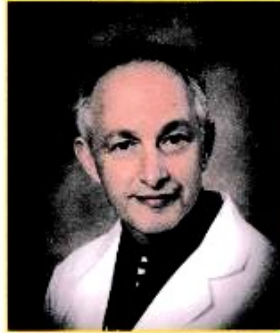

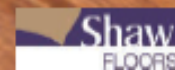

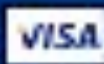
