## **REMINDERS & UPDATES:**

Anyone that is still waiting for Construction work on your home and if you have not been notified then we ask you to please contact the office with any time frames so we can update our inspection list. Thank you.

**CALENDAR SCHEDULING:** You need to either Email or Drop off a written request of the date you would like to schedule on the calendar. It should include: Your Name, Contact Number, Date and (Time start and end) of your Event, Name of the event, Location of Event: \* Siesta, \*\*Cantina, 19 Nineteenth Hole. You are responsible for checking the calendar to see if the day/time you wish to schedule an event is available. Then submit it to the office. If there is no competing event then we will happily add to the calendar. If we find an event scheduled during the time you are requesting we will make you aware to either speak to other event holder or change your event date/time and re-submit. We do not monitor face book on any daily schedule and if you put an event notice out onto face book it will not automatically appear on the schedule, event holder is responsible to contact office to ask to have it added to the calendar.

**WATER TURN ON** – Requests to TURN-ON or OFF water, need be during business hours Monday through Friday (8:00AM thru 3:00PM) **and** you must have an authorized representative (or be there yourself) in the house at the time water is turned on.

**RENTING OR SELLING:** *LET SYLVIA KNOW IN THE OFFICE. THE OFFICE CANNOT PROCESS ANY APPLICATION RECEIVED WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE CURRENT HOME OWNER.* Renters need to register at the office for guest passes and a rental information packet upon arrival.

## **OTHER ITEMS TO REMEMBER**

- ◆ Do NOT feed the wild animals, they are not pets and it is part of the Florida State law statutes that feeding most wildlife is against the law!
- ◆ The cows in the fields bordering the Village - - are privately owned, feeding them is against the law!
- ◆ Pickup after your pet is a Village Rule . ALL PETS must be on a leash when out of their home. No pet is to be tied up outside of the home. No pet is to be left unattended outside of the home.
- ◆ Please ask all deliveries and contractors during gate closed hours to call (***your house number***) residents have access to open the gate for their own deliveries and visitors. Security is for emergency gate access as needed. Contact the office for instructions or to be programmed into the gate. Resident's please ask any large furniture or contractor deliveries that will be a heavy load to use the gate in the Front or Back of village respective to where you live. Thank you.
- ◆ RV parking is allowed (2) days in front of house to Load and Unload. After 2 days you need to park in the RV lot and can only bring over for (4) hours at a time for working on/in your RV unit as needed. No RV, Boats, Trailers allowed parked in driveway longer than the 2-Days.
- ◆ DO NOT Park in empty lots near your home. It delays maintenance work from being done on lots as needed and any vehicles found parking in lots will be charged for any broken lines or services on empty lots.
- ◆ Please have your Homes Washed and Gutters cleaned out and all Trimming around your home completed ASAP.
- ◆ All visitors should carry a (Yellow) visitor pass with them when visiting any public area of the village. Visitors under 18 years of age must be with a resident or a visitor over the age of 18 carrying a visitor pass. No Visitors under the age of 18 may drive a Golf Cart in the village.

If someone asks you or a family member if you are a resident or visitor, please do not take offense. We want to keep the Village residents safe for all residents and their registered guests and prevent non village people from using the village amenities. Asking is our way to help you enjoy the village fully without concern.

The HOA will also represent the residents in the remote possibility that Arcadia Village is ever listed for sale, A negotiation team meets with the owners to negotiate the yearly lot rent, and we provide liability insurance coverage for all HOA members who organize and run events. We also listen and try to address many residents concerns with the owner.

## HOA CONTINUED

### Rental Information 2023

We currently have 493 occupied homes of which 13 have a life time lease, 106 have a CPI (based on Consumer Price Index lease and the balance 374 have standard leases.

We can only negotiate the standard leases. In order to meet with the owners, we need 2/3 of the 374 authorizations. We needed 249 signatures.

This year our committee consist of Mary Dajczak, Karen Elmore, Linda Hamilton, Don Kiran, Shirl Pumphrey and myself, Beth Patrus. In May each member was assigned a number of committees to contact to obtain the information in order to determine how it compared what was provided to us from the Freeman's was accurate.

Freeman's purchases a data comp from JLT marketing the beginning of June. They compare our community to those community that are over 350 occupied homes in Highlands/Desoto County, Polk County, Manatee County, and Sarasota County.

Each year the committee members will contact the communities that the Freeman's compared us to the prior year. They need to obtain the average lot rent, do they charge to remove garbage, do they charge to cut the lawn, do they charge for water/sewage and do they have a pass-through charge. Pass through charges can be, property taxes, insurance, utilities, janitorial charges, security and or supply cost.

The committee found that Arcadia Village was approximately 18% less than all other communities. AV lot rent includes, water/sewage, lawn cutting and trash removal twice a week where most other communities do not. Many communities also have an additional pass-through charge.

The committee agreed that the month-to-month lot rent will increase by \$33.00 a month in 2024 and \$35 a month in 2025.

CPI leases are not negotiable. This lease agreement is CPI plus 1%. As of July 31<sup>st</sup> the CPI was 3.1

The committee made the following:

- Professional cleaning of both clubhouses.

- They have hired L & L to clean the clubhouses monthly.

- Re-pair and re-surface Tennis and Shuffleboard courts.

- The Tennis court has been completed.

- The Shuffleboard courts will be done by the end of October.

- New pool lounges at both pools.

- They have replaced 6 loungers and re-strapped those that were repairable.

- Painting of benches an gazebo in common area.

- Sorrento Circle clearing in the preserve. They have done this

- Repairs on homes that have not been done yet. They sent letters or contacted the homeowners for update on progress.

## Note to Golf Cart Users

A Desoto County Sheriff representative came to the office to review the Golf Cart path law. They asked us to share an update with residents.

For the sake of simplicity, he explained that crossing a county road is illegal. AND, both roads (NE Canal Avenue and NE Polk Avenue) along the cart path between AVCC and Winn Dixie parking lot are county roads. Additionally, crossing Highway 70 is also illegal and you will get a ticket if seen.

With that being said, they are not looking to stop golf carts that are going down the side to Winn Dixie parking lot and parking right there by the store where it has a sign golf cart parking.

HOWEVER, carts that push the envelope and drive through the parking lot, cross the streets at the lights heading on down the block further toward Circle K and similar or who attempt to cross Rte. 70 – will be issued tickets if the Sheriff or City catches them.

Due to some carts not making smart decisions, the Sheriff's office and the Arcadia City Police have received numerous complaints. This has forced their legal team to now re-review and advise them on how to handle the golf cart offenses.

So do not go where you should not go! Avoid the ticket.

Finally, Another reminder from the Sheriff Office: Remember it is illegal for anyone without a driver's license to operate a golf cart.

## Acorn Squash with Wild Rice Stuffing

Stuffed Squash for the win every holiday meal.

The squash and the stuffing, minus the pecans, can be prepared a day ahead and refrigerated separately. Stir the pecans into the rice mixture just before filling the squash. Heat in the oven at 350 degrees for 20 to 30 minutes. **Makes: 2 to 4 servings**

### Ingredients:

½ cup chopped pecans	2 acorn squash
2 Tablespoon Vegetable broth (divided)	Salt and ground pepper to taste
2 tablespoons minced onion	½ cup wild rice, rinsed and well-drained
½ cup brown rice	2 cups vegetable broth or water
½ cup celery (1-2 rib), chopped	½ teaspoon ground sage
½ teaspoon dried thyme	1 tablespoon chopped fresh parsley
½ cup dried cranberries	

### Preparation:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Place pecans on cookie sheet and toast in oven, watching carefully, until browned and fragrant, about 5 minutes or less. Remove from oven and set aside to cool.

Use a serrated knife to cut each squash in half crosswise. Cut a small slice from bottom of each half to make it balance better. Scoop out seeds. Brush squash flesh with 1 tablespoon vegetable broth and season to taste with salt and freshly ground pepper. Place, cavity side down, in roasting pan. Cover with foil and bake at 350 degrees about 45 minutes or until squash can be pierced with a fork.

Meanwhile, heat remaining 1 tablespoon vegetable broth in large saucepan over medium heat, add onion and cook, stirring occasionally, until tender adding another tablespoon of broth or water as needed Stir in wild and brown rice and cook 1 minute. Stir in vegetable broth or water and celery and bring to a boil. Cover, reduce heat and simmer 45 to 50 minutes or until rice is tender.

Drain any remaining liquid. Stir in sage, thyme and salt and pepper to taste. Add parsley, cranberries and reserved pecans, and combine. Fill squash cavity of each half with rice mixture and serve, placing any remaining stuffing in a serving bowl.
