Our HOA needs you and your support.

Our numbers are dwindling along with our community's enthusiasm. Our HOA has no authority however we do have a strong voice for everyone. The board works closely with both Ron Jr and Sylvia. They do hear what we are saying.

If we did not have an HOA, the Freeman's would not be obligated to negotiate our yearly rental agreements. The state statute, 723 requires them to sit down with the HOA and discuss the increase.

Your HOA also provides a liability insurance policy to cover all our active chairpersons. This policy is about \$2,300 a year. Our members' dues help pay for this. Fortunately, both the Chinese action and the Arcadia Newsletter have made donations to help cover the cost of the insurance.

Over the past few years, the HOA board has met with Ron Jr about a number of items that needed attention. One was the Siesta Clubhouse. They then painted it, new fans inside and out plus a smart TV. Other items that the HOA requested was to resurface the pickle ball court and the tennis court. They power wash both pool decks on a weekly basis. We continue to ask that you double up in your golf carts. This helps to reduce the wear and tear on our beautiful course, and please try and use the 90 degree rule when driving on the fairways to get to your ball. Everyone's help is needed and appreciated.

2024 A.V.C.C. Golf Dues

- * A single household is \$620.00. 2 person household with only 1golfer is \$620.00.
-A statement of agreement must be signed for all single memberships.
- * A household with 2 golfers is \$665.00.
-This is a \$3.75 per month increase over 2023.
- * A 1 month rental is \$500.00. * Greater than a 1 month rental is \$995.00.

These increases are due to the all around increased rates of maintaining our golf course.

German Apple Pie

My mother would make this special apple pie for the holidays. It really is delicious!!

Rich, smooth, and creamy German Apple Pie is like no other apple pie you've ever tasted.

- 6 medium apples peeled, cored and sliced, she used granny smith apples
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup all-purpose or brown rice flour
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 single pie crust

Instructions:

Press the pie crust into the bottom of a deep 9" pie plate. Crimp the edges (if you are feeling fancy) or simply smooth the edges until they are relatively smooth. Whisk together the dry ingredients and sprinkle over the apples in a large mixing bowl.

Stir to coat all the pieces and then place the apples into the pie crust. Pour the cream over the apples and bake at 450 degrees for 15 minutes. Reduce the heat to 350 degrees and bake for an additional 55-60 minutes. Cool completely before serving. Enjoy!

The Seacoast Communities Blood Bank is returning to Arcadia Village.

Tuesday January 16,2024 12:00PM to 5:00PM.

Sign up sheets will be in both clubhouses. (To avoid double booking please advise us if you are already registered for a booked time elsewhere with AVCC code 440.) The bus holds 8 donors at a time and will be on the tennis court side of Cantina Clubhouse for collecting whole blood or double red blood cells. Your blood is used by a local hospital to save lives. You never know when you or a loved one will need this precious gift. Blood supply is critically low

You will receive free Covid 19 antibody testing, cholesterol check, blood type, blood pressure, temperature, pulse and iron count (hemoglobin). There is a donor rewards program on line which will earn points for you toward gifts for your donations. (Please bring your ID)

Frequently asked questions:

What are Double Donations? Double red blood cells are collected and fluid is returned to the donor. The patient gets two pints of blood from the same person rather than mixing two donations. You need to wait 108 days before you can donate again. Donating one pint in January allows you to donate doubles in March.

Do Canadians donate in the USA? Yes, some of our most frequent donors are Canadians.

- ⇒ What are the age limits? 16 is the minimum age limit and no maximum age. (110 pounds is the minimum weight)
- ⇒ Can I donate if I am diabetic? Yes with use of diabetic medication.
- ⇒ Can I donate if I have had a recent vaccine? Yes
- ⇒ Can I donate if I am on birth control pills? Yes (WOW You really ARE reading this article!)
- ⇒ Can I donate if I have cancer? Basil and Squamish cell yes. Most cancer survivors can donate after a year cancer free.
- ⇒ Can I donate after a new tattoo? Yes after four weeks.

If it is more convenient for you to donate elsewhere in the Suncoast area, please give code 440 to have your donation credited to Arcadia Village CC.

Perhaps your schedule conflicts with the blood mobile availability. You are welcome to call 844-972-6819 for the concierge little bus to come to your house to collect your blood donation.

If you question about your ability to donate, there are criteria posted on the bulletin board or **call Wayne or Arline at 207-669-5602 with questions or concerns**

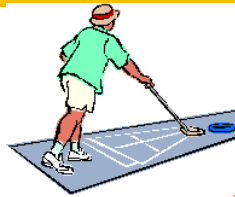

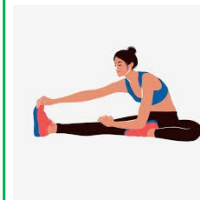

Hello Fellow Villagers!

So, you have an overwhelming craving for pizza, and although Wawa has some pretty decent offerings and prices for their pizzas, it's nice to sit down, have a beverage or 2, and just enjoy the aromas and ambiance and eat on real plates and silverware! I will share with you some of the places we've checked out and give you my opinion of our chomping...

Thus far, Galati's (637 S Commerce Ave. Sebring) has my current favorite pizza. It's a small, quaint little place. They offer Italian dishes, a small salad bar; however, we went straight for the pizza. They have a family size pizza that's as big as a manhole cover, but we got a significantly smaller one. Absolutely delish – nice, thin crust, but had an excellent chew to it. We will definitely return. Oh, small family owned and local.

For years, when we lived in North Port, we got hooked on Pioneers Pizza, both in Port Charlotte and Punta Gorda. Now they are no longer owned by the same owners anymore, so not sure if it's still the same menu. Their pizzas you can choose between Roman or NY style. We like the NY style. Best deal is the personal pizza, you can get unlimited toppings included. That's especially nice when you want something different than anyone else in your party. Now here's where I'm going to stray...I delude myself into thinking I'm a very good judge of antipasto salad, and of all of them I've devoured over the years, theirs is the absolute best. Luigi's runs a close second, but more about them next. Although you may think that it's pricey for just a "salad", it's loaded with meats, cheeses, and all the other goodies.

Next on my list is Luigi's in Port Charlotte. They run amazing specials, and they have a yummy cauliflower crust pizza. They also have the BEST garlic rolls ever, and I dare you to eat just one! Their antipasto salad is also loaded with plenty of toppings, and even at ordering a half sized one, you don't walk out of there hungry. And their eggplant parm is delicious. Lastly, I treated myself to their pumpkin pie martini. Let's just say that after I tasted it, I needed a moment to myself (bahahahahaha).

Now this one may be a bit contentious; however, I'm just sharing my experiences. Went to Giovanni's Main Street Kitchen in Wachula.
