WHAT DO I DO WITH?

When you are moving into your new home if you find you do not need a piece of furniture or curtains or you're going to purchase new towels and sheets, there are several options for getting rid of stuff you do not want or need.

1st – If it is junk, broken or too big for a trash can or trash bag you will need to dispose of it at the Desoto County Landfill. See your directory for address and phone number of local landfill.

Or- Is the Chinese Auction Room, they will take dishes, lamps, appliances, and golf clubs, almost anything from the home. You can drop off the item at the Auction Room located in the Cantina Club House next door to the Quilting room. Any questions about donation contact Rene Krauss or Janette Brockway, phone numbers can be found in the directory.

Or- is North Hillsborough Baptist Church Resource Center: 253 N Hillsborough Ave, Arcadia Fl. 34266 – Phone: 863-494-3455. The church helps anyone who has lost items from a house fire, storm related loss, other disaster. The Church receives donated items and gives them away free to people who need a new kitchen setup, new bedroom, etc. They also will take almost any types of donations, food, clothing, furniture, appliances, towels, bedding, pet supplies, clothing, and shoes. They do not take sports equipment, Knick knacks, jewelry.

And - Habitat for Humanity will take donations and will also send out a truck for large items and any other household items that you want to donate. They will take sports equipment and Knick knacks and furniture and more. Contact them for more details. Phone: 863-494-6456

If you are selling or if you are putting it for free (item from home), use Facebook, if you put it in your driveway it must be removed after (2) days.

NO CHILDREN/GRANDCHILDREN DRIVING GOLF CARTS: It is a state law and will incur a violation letter.

Anyone driving a golf cart must be over the age of 18 and possess a valid driver's license to drive a golf cart.

HOME MAINTENANCE: REMEMBER to walk around your home and to look up, look for mold, weeds, holes, damage and or general maintenance that may be needed around your home.

Stand out front and look at your house from the street. Do you see your house number displayed so it can be seen? Can the Fire Department or Ambulance or Delivery drivers see your house number/name?

Home Construction:

Please remind your contractors of quiet hours until 8:30 am per the Rules and Regulations. Ask them to be courteous to neighbors of the homes they are working on when starting repairs in the morning hours.

Very Important*: Ask delivery drivers to use the BACK GATE if you live North of Bridge and to use the FRONT GATE if you South of Bridge.

For Back Gate they can dial your house number and you can let them in by pressing 9#. Contact the office if you need further assistant

Club House Kitchen's When using the kitchens for any event public or private, it is the responsibility of the group using the facility to clean up all areas used and to return all furniture to it proper locations and to also take all trash out to the dumpster.

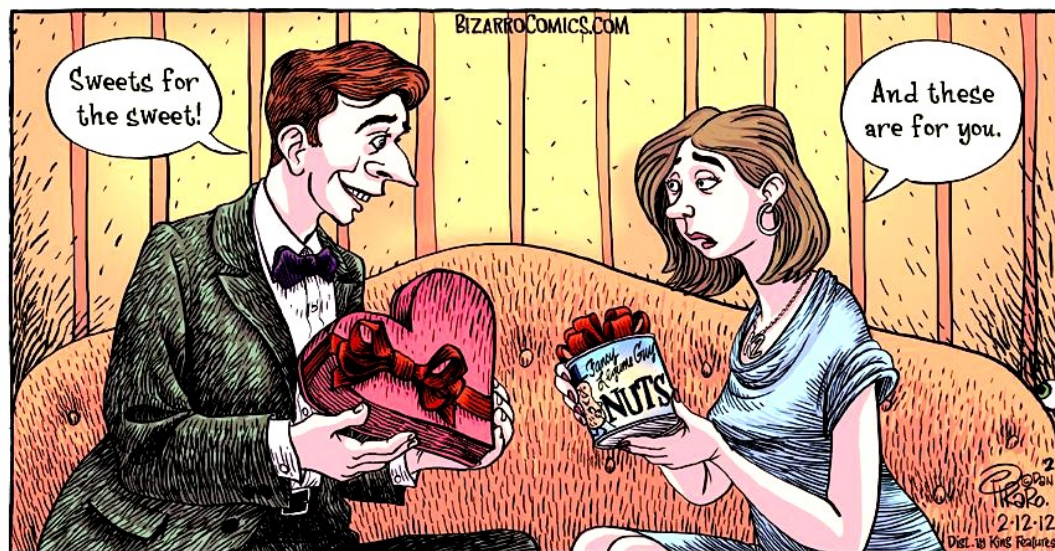
Go-to places not downtown:
