<u>VISITOR TAGS</u>: Register visitors with the office and grab a yellow visitor tag, then return them to the office when visitors leave. Anyone under 18 years of age must be in the presence of an adult over 18 while at any amenity in the village.

<u>DO NOT FEED THE WILDLIFE</u>: Do Not Feed ducks, Alligators, sandhill cranes or ANY other wildlife. FEEDING WILDLIFE LEADS TO Bacterial Pollution, and <u>Creates an imbalance in Native Ecology</u>, Illness and Deformities of wildlife, and they lose fear of Humans and the wrong wildlife animal could approach you unwillingly.



It takes only one mistake. - - - Reminder to all residents, their guests, and their renters to follow the **Speed Limit of 15-MHP** and to **stop** at corners and at stop signs.

For Seasonal Residents leaving in March and April:

- We recommend and would appreciate anyone leaving for several weeks or month(s) put away all outside items that could become projectiles or fly away in high winds causing damage to your home and or locations around you, don't forget hose that might be connected to outside faucet.
- Check your outside lights, make sure they are working, non-working lights let people know you are not home. LED replacement will save on your electrical bill.
- Ropes across your driveway say you're not home, a neighbor borrowing your driveway occasionally over the summer signals someone may be home, thereby being a discouragement.
- Notify the office in a timely fashion when leaving. Make sure they have a current phone number to reach you should there be a reason. In addition, let the office know what day to have your water turned off. You should be present to turn off your water heater at the same time. Please schedule ahead of time during office hours.

Please return Guest passes promptly so others can use them and avoid replacement charges.

Spare Key's – Have you thought of a spare key, through a neighbor, house sitter or office for any service personnel during your absence, if you have an issue and would like to give access to your home for repairs. *NOTE: If your house is listed for sale, office personnel living on-site do not have access to the keys outside of office hours.



recipient. Double red cell donors have to allow 108 days between donations. Minimum weight is 110 pounds. Diabetics can donate if they are regulated with diabetic medicine. Advanced age does not limit eligibility. Cancer survivors can donate after one year cancer free.
