

ARCADIA

Arcadia is a city and county seat of DeSoto County with a historic district listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It has a rich history of orange growing, cattle-raising and hosting rodeos as well as the DeSoto County Fair and the Watermelon Festival. Arcadia also has a variety of spots for camping, boating and other outdoor recreation. Nearby is the Bearadise Ranch Bear Preserve established in 1926 as a learning facility to promote awareness for habitat preservation and conservation for all bear species.

BABCOCK RANCH

Babcock Ranch is a solar-powered community in southeastern Charlotte County and northeastern Lee County. It also is a regional outdoor adventure destination because of its trails, lakes and eco-tours. The community has a charter school, restaurants, a lakeside boardwalk and a band shell for live entertainment.

BOCA GRANDE

Boca Grande is an affluent residential community and resort town on Gasparilla Island. It is highlighted by a circa-1890 lighthouse and has a walking- and bikingfriendly downtown small shops and restaurants. The Gasparilla Inn, with its three croquest lawns, is the centerpiece. Boca Grande has long been an elite retreat for business leaders, politicans and movie stars, including Katherine Hepburn.

ENGLEWOOD

Englewood straddles two counties, Charlotte and Sarasota. The heart of the arts district,

as well as popular restaurants, is on West Dearborn Street. The Ringling College of Art & Design also has a center in town. Visitors can hike, camp and ride bikes just east of Englewood in Myakka State Forest. Nearby Manasota Key, a beautiful barrier Island, is home to the Hermitage Artist Retreat where some of the nation's top artists escape to create.

NORTH FORT MYERS

North Fort Myers is on the Caloosahatchee River and has a blend of town and country. There are plenty of restaurants and shops as well as nature trails and rural attractions such as the Rosy Tomorrows Heritage Farm. It's also home to The Shell Factory, the world's largest collection of shells and coral.

NORTH PORT

The community has more than 26 parks and open spaces which appeal to people who love the outdoors. There are several miles of horse trails, mountain bike trails and natural hiking paths. Myakka State Forest is just south of North Port, and is a great spot for hiking and camping. Also nearby is Warm Mineral Springs visited by thousands of people seeking the soothing mineral waters believed to be helpful in healing many ailments.

PORT CHARLOTTE

The unincorporated community has a variety of shopping, recreation and cultural opportunities. The Port Charlotte Town Center is the area's major mall and the Charlotte Sports Park is the spring-training home to the Tampa Bay Rays. Port Charlotte has more than 165 miles of waterways providing access to Charlotte Harbor and the Gulf of Mexico. Tippecanoe Environmental Park offers hiking trails and wildlife viewing through 380 acres of scrub and pine flat-woods.

PUNTA GORDA

The city is the only incorporated community in Charlotte County. It reinvented itself after Hurricane Charley in 2004 but retained its Old Florida feel with its charming historic downtown that has restaurants, shops and galleries. Situated along the water where the Peace River meets the Charlotte Harbor, it attracts people to the Harborwalk and Fishermen's Village. The Charlotte Harbor & Events Center also has a variety of shows and events.

SARASOTA

This city was once the winter home of the Ringling Brothers Circus and offers a blend of culture, fine dining, pristine beaches and shopping opportunities. Attractions include the John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art, Ca' d'Zan Mansion and Marie Selby Botanical Gardens. St. Armand's Circle, Burns Square and Main Street downtown are popular shopping spots.

VENICE

Venice takes its name from its more famous Italian namesake. It has a charming historic mainstreet with northern Italian architecture and beautifully landscaped boulevards full of quaint shops and restaurants. Venice also is known as the "Shark Tooth Capital of the World." Vacationers enjoy the beaches, golf courses, nature trails and other outdoor activities.

WELLEN PARK

Wellen Park is a collection of communities in both North Port and Venice with resort-style amenities and planned activities. Each have different builders and atmospheres. The nearby CoolToday Park is home to the Atlanta Braves spring training but also has multi-purpose fields for year-round activities including youth sports and special events.





AREA BEACHES

t's just a short drive from anyplace in Southwest Florida to a beautiful beach. The easiest Gulf of Mexico beaches to access are Manasota Key, which offers miles of uncluttered shoreline, and four public parks that allow very different beach-going experiences and are easy to access by car. Just a short drive to the south are the beautiful beaches of Boca Grande and Gasparilla Island State Park. If you have access to a boat, your choice of beaches increases, as you can visit Don Pedro Island State Park, Little Gasparilla Island, Cayo Costa State Park and more.

MANASOTA KEY

Englewood Beach/Chadwick Park 2100 N. Beach Road, Englewood

This large beach is Charlotte County's main park on the Gulf of Mexico. It's an easy drive over two bridges that span beautiful Lemon Bay and the Intracoastal Waterway. Englewood Beach features swimming, fishing, shelling, picnic shelters, barbecue grills, birding opportunities and wooden walkways. There are also updated playgrounds, basketball courts, beach volleyball and horseshoe pits. There's a newly refurbished shower and restroom facility and a recently paved parking lot. There is a small fee to park, and self-service parking passes sold from machines.

This popular public beach is also across North Beach Road from several great

STUMP PASS BEACH STATE PARK 900 Gulf Blvd., Englewood

If you like nature and a little more seclusion, Stump Pass Beach State Park is for you. In addition to swimming, nature trails, birding, shelling and fishing, this beach operated by the Florida State Park system offers winding coastal nature trails, a picnic pavilion, a canoe/kayak launch, showers and restrooms, and access to Stump Pass, the waterway that links the Gulf of Mexico with Lemon Bay. There is a small fee to use this park, and you should plan to bring your own amenities like snacks and drinks.

MANASOTA BEACH PARK

8570 Manasota Key Road, Englewood Blind Pass Beach Park

6725 Manasota Key Road, Englewood

Sarasota County operates two beaches on Manasota Key, Manasota Beach Park to the north, and Blind Pass Beach Park, which locals call "Middle Beach," near the middle of the key. Both are easily accessible by car and offer swimming, fishing, shelling and birding opportunities with ample parking and updated restrooms and showers. Manasota Beach has its own boat dock on the Intracoastal Waterway, while Blind Pass has a canoe and kayak launch on its bayside. Blind Pass also has a fun playground for the kids.

BOCA GRANDE PUBLIC BEACHES

Third Street and other locations

There are 14 public Gulf of Mexico beaches, but they're not always easy to find. Not all have parking, and because of erosion, some offer only a beautiful view of the Gulf of Mexico. If you drive south on Gilchrist Boulevard, which turns into Gulf Boulevard, the Gulf beaches are on your right, at the end of each street. Farther south, there are 14 walking paths from Gulf Boulevard to the beach. There are also 11 bayside access points.

On the southern end of the island, Gasparilla Island State Park is on the right, and has a public parking lot, with the larger portion of the park about a quarter mile south. Both parks have swimming and fishing opportunities, and each features its own unique lighthouse.

ISLAND BEACHES

Don Pedro Island State Park 8450 Placida Road, Placida Cayo Costa State Park 4 Nautical Miles West of Pine Island, Cayo Costa

If you have access to a boat, there are lots of additional public beach parks you can enjoy. The Florida State Park service operates Don Pedro Island State Park, which is in Placida near Englewood, and Cayo Costa State Park, which is south of Boca Grande Pass. Both offer swimming, boating, canoe/kayak, hiking, picnicking, snorkeling/diving, fishing, camping in small primitive cabins or tents.

PORT CHARLOTTE Port charlotte beach

One of the easiest beaches to reach from Port Charlotte or Punta Gorda is Port Charlotte Beach. It offers a sandy sunning area along Charlotte Harbor, plus boat ramps, basketball and tennis courts, picnic tables and a dog park. It also has a large swimming pool that offers aerobics, swimming lessons and cool open swim.

VENICE Venice Beach

The unique "sail" style pavilion at the beach is an iconic landmark along with the beach restroom building. The beach is in city limits but is maintained by Sarasota County, including its concession area. Parking is free and lifeguards are available. Camping is not allowed on the beach and fires are also prohibited.

CASPERSEN BEACH

Search for sharks' teeth and hike the nature trails at Caspersen Beach. Public restrooms, showers, canoe launch, fishing and a playground.

alkers and cyclists put the sidewalks and pathways to good use in Punta Gorda.

Eighteen miles of lighted, landscaped and level paths called Punta Gorda Pathways wander through downtown and along Charlotte Harbor. Many stop along the way to enjoy lunch, watch boats, and maybe even spot a dolphin along the way.

Trail riding a favorite pastime? Look up the Pioneer Cape Haze Trail in the western part of the county. Another spectacular ride is the Babcock/ Webb Wildlife Management Area.

If you enjoy longer rides there are four signed routes starting from Gilchrist Park in Punta Gorda.

The Tour de Punta Gorda is an 18-mile route primarily in the city limits.

The Bridges route takes us 32 miles and finds 12 mountains (OK, maybe they're bridges) to climb

two of which cross over Charlotte Harbor.
 The Tropical Gulf Route is 28 miles through

some neighborhoods and then out into some forested, quiet areas of the county, again with an excellent chance to see Florida wildlife.

Finally, the Washington Loop route, one of the locals' favorites, is a 30-mile circuit traveling out of the city through horse farms and rural areas of Charlotte County.

AREA PARKS

OLD FLORIDA PARKS MYAKKA STATE FOREST

Within the city limits of North Port, just off River Road, is Myakka State Forest. The state forest is more than 8,500 acres that includes miles of hiking and biking trails. The park also offers canoe launches, picnic areas and rural camping for those who enjoy a primitive lifestyle, including a campsite right along the Myakka River. It also allows some small-game hunting during certain times of the year. 2000 S. OSCAR SCHERER STATE PARK



MYAKKA RIVER STATE PARK

Located about a half-hour drive from West Villages — north on Interstate 75 and east on State Road 72. And while alligators are all over Florida, they are especially known to live in the state park. It is home to Deep Hole, a sink hole about 2 miles away from the rest of the park. After the hike, you may see between 30 and more than 200 alligators basking or swimming in the body of water. To take in that adventure, you must receive a wilderness permit from the state park's ranger station at the front of the property.

There is a limited number given out each day and are often taken within minutes of the park's 8 a.m. opening. The state park, one of the state's oldest, also has boat tours on Myakka Lake where you can view wildlife. A popular part of the state park is the canopy walk, a short hike from the main road.

For those willing to take it, there's a structure to check out, 76 feet in the air and above the tree canopy — giving a new view on Old Florida.

here is nothing dogs like better than running around with their owners and socializing with other canines.

There are dog specific parks and dog-friendly parks across Southwest Florida. Just be sure to check the websites to familiarize yourself with the rules.

Among the rules: Animals should not disturb other park users, other animals or resources by being noisy, dangerous, intimidating or destructive. They also may not be left unattended in parked vehicles or be tethered to any tree, plant, building or park equipment.

Some city parks, beaches, piers and playgrounds don't allow any dogs unless they are service dogs.

Most dog parks require dogs be vaccinated and display current tags in accordance with state law and county ordinance.

Some require leashes or that small dogs and large dogs play in separate areas.

Also, don't forget to clean up after your pup.

Hounds on Henry at 1098 W Virginia Ave. in Punta Gorda, the Canine Club Dog Park at 6442 Appomattox Dr in North Port, Edgewater Paw Park at 22410 Glass Lane in Port Charlotte and Ann & Chuck Dever Regional Paw Park at 6791 San Casa Drive in Englewood have leash-free areas.
