- ❑ Remember : If you rent your home for a month or more, you will need to have an application completed before they arrive on site. All Renters must fill out a new application to help us with the new systems.
- ❑ All trash must be in a 13-gallon bag or larger, including dog pick up bags. Trash needs to be on the curb by 7:30 am. If you want to put trash out the night before, please put it into a trash can with a secure lid. Trash on the curb that has been torn apart by animals will not be picked up by our trash crew. We also request that you do not overfill or make bags too heavy for our staff to lift over their heads. We do not want anyone to get hurt or injured.

RESIDENT RENTING SEASONALLY MIN-1MONTH MAX-5MONTHS

RESIDENT HOMEOWNER. Contact the office by email to notify us that you will be renting your home for a month or for a season. Give the office the renter name(s), phone number and the months they will be renting your home.

RENTER. Once the office has been notified, please have the renter contact the office to complete an application.
*New: Applications cost \$40.00 per applicant.

All Renters must register with the office during office hours to register their stay.

All previous and new renters must complete an application for 2025/2026 season.

RESIDENT VISITORS

COMMUNITY VISITORS AND GUEST. All Arcadia Village visitors and guests, for stays in excess of twenty-four (24) hours, must be registered at the village office. Such visitors and guests are welcome to resident at no charge by management, providing, however, that their visitation at Arcadia Village does not exceed a period of fifteen (15) consecutive days or 30 total days per calendar year.

CONDUCT OF RESIDENTS & THEIR GUESTS. As respected residents of ARCADIA VILLAGE, it is vitally important that we respect our neighbor's rights to privacy, peace and quiet and the moral as well as legal rights they have to their property. In acknowledgment of this respect, disturbing noises of any nature whatsoever are not permitted at any time. Quiet is required between the hours of 10:00 PM and 8:30 AM. Televisions, radios, stereos, and related audio-video devices must be operated at a normal to low level at all times so as not to disturb neighboring residents. Disorderly conduct, physical abusiveness in public, intoxication, use of profane language, and similar unfavorable conduct by residents or their guests is strictly forbidden and will not be tolerated by the management under any circumstances whatsoever and residents will be held accountable. Any individual or individuals causing disturbances or whose actions cause them to become a nuisance may be required to vacate ARCADIA VILLAGE at the sole discretion of the management. No glass containers are allowed in the pool areas. Residents and their guests will observe all signs for pool conduct.

Residents are responsible for their guests. Please make sure all visitors follow rules and regulations as well as common sense.

No Children under the Age of 18 are allowed to drive a Golf Court

No Children under the Age of 18 are permitted or go to any amenity without a resident or guest carrying a guest pass.
