Holiday Trash Pick-up for Thanksgiving Week will be on Wednesday 11/26

PASSES: All Residents must carry their green or red resident pass. And all Visitors must carry their yellow visitor pass to all events and amenities. We will be checking, and you will need to go home to get your pass if you do not have it on you. No Visitors under the age of 18 may drive a Golf Cart in the village. No Visitor under the age of 18 is allowed alone at any amenity without resident or adult over 18 years of age. If someone asks you or a family member if you are a resident or visitor, please do not take offense. We want to keep the Village residents safe for all residents and their registered guests and prevent non village people from using the village amenities. Asking is our way of helping you enjoy the village and just might meet a new friend.

TRASH SCHEDULE: YOU CAN SEE ONE IN EVERY NEWSLETTER AND MAIL STATION BULLETIN BOARD.

WATER TURN ON — Requests to TURN-ON or OFF water, needs to be during business hours Monday through Friday 8:00AM thru 3:00PM and you must have an authorized representative (or be there yourself) in the house at the time water is turned on.

CALENDAR SCHEDULING: You need to Email or Drop off a written request for the calendar, what is needed: 1st you must check the calendar to make sure the day & time you are looking to schedule for is available. If the calendar has an opening, please bring to the office the event you would like scheduled. We need to know the following:

1. Name of the Event, 2. Date of Event, 3 Start and End time of Event, 4. Location of Event: example * Siesta, **Cantina or (19) Nineteenth Hole and finally, the Name and Contact Number of the coordinator of event.

RENTING OR SELLING: Let the office know. The office cannot process any applications without the permission of the current homeowner.

ALL APPLICATIONS NOW HAVE A FEE OF \$40.00 PER PERSON.

Approved Renters need to register at the office for guest passes and a rental information packet upon arrival.

Other items to REMEMBER.

- ❖ Do NOT feed wild animals, they are not pets and it is part of the Florida State law statutes that feeding/watering most wild-life is against the law!
- ❖ The cows in the fields bordering the Village are privately owned and feeding them is against the law! They have trail Cam's, do not get a sheriff visit for Foolishness.
- ❖ Any improvements or upgrades to the outside of your home: patio pavers, cart path addition, concrete, painting, (not a complete list), need approval. Please stop by the office for a list of guidelines.
- ❖ During gate-closed hours ask all after-hour delivery, contractors, visitors to call (your house number) residents have access to open the gate for their own deliveries and visitors. Security is for emergency gate access. Contact the office for instructions to open . Resident's should ask any large and heavy truck deliveries to use the gate in the Front or Back of village respective to where you live.
- ❖ RV parking is allowed (2) days in front of house to Load and Unload. After 2 days you need to park in the RV lot and can bring over for (4) hours at a time as needed. No RV, Boats, Trailers allowed to park in driveway longer than 2-Days.
- ❖ DO NOT Park in empty lots near your home. It delays maintenance and mowing of lots getting done as needed and any vehicles found parking in lots will be charged for any broken lines or services on empty lots.

Rules for 18 Hole Points League

We are playing on Thursday...Contact Terry Elmore as soon as possible if you can't play. If you can't play the day of please contact one of your team mates so they are not waiting for you to show up. On a bad weather day league will be counted if most get there round completed.

We will be using suggested tee times again this year. Starting at 9AM we will be going off the front and back. **Reminder...** the course is not closed to our league especially on the back so get inline and enjoy your round.

Points will be awarded for team play, individual points for making required points 1 point, making over your points 2 points, player of the week 2 points, closest to the pin 1 point and skins 1 point.

Team points are 5 for first, 4 for second, 3 for third and 2 for fourth.

Here is how the points are calculated... Boogie is 1 point... Par is 2 points... Birdie is 3 points... Eagle is 4 points... Hole in One 5 points... Double bogey or higher is 0 points.

Each Player has so many points they are required to get... for every 2 points above required points your quota will go up 1 with a maximum of 3 each week... for every 4 points below your quota your required points will go down 1 with a maximum of 3 each week.

All players must putt out the hole. **NO GIMMES**

If you think your ball has gone out of bounds from the tee play a provisional from the tee, You are hitting 3. Ball in water hit from where you think it entered or if there is a drop zone use it.

Scorecards will be in the red mailbox in the carport at lot 756 Sorrento Circle. Pick up and drop off

when round is completed.

League results and schedule will be posted week by week. I will post them on the new Arcadia Village 18 Hole League Facebook Page. Thanks for all of you for showing interest in this league. **PLEASE DOUBLE UP IN CARTS!!!**
