HOME MAINTENANCE:

REMEMBER to walk around your home and look up, look for mold, weeds, holes, damage and or general maintenance that may be needed around your home.

Stand out front and look at your house from the street. Do you see your house number displayed so it can be seen? Can the Fire Department or Ambulance find your house easily? Do you have weeds peeking out of your gutter, do you have weeds or overgrown bushes.

Inspections will be end of January and beginning of February.

NO CAR, TRAILER OR RV PARKING IN EMPTY LOTS! Park maintenance cannot mow or otherwise maintain the property correctly – and you risk possibly doing major damage to underground utilities. As stated in the Rules and Regulations: Street Parking is 4-hour parking limit, (not including contractors), for longer than 4 hours please park at a Club House with your parking permit on your dash for identification.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

25. HOUSEHOLD PETS AND OTHER ANIMALS

Household pets of any type or breed whatsoever are allowed in the homes of residents only upon being approved by the management.

All pets, regardless of category, must be registered with the management and such pets must be in possession of current licenses and shots as required by all governmental authorities. When pets are taken outside, pets must always be in the custody of their resident owner, without exception, and properly leashed.

The resident owner is required to clean up after pet has defecated. No pet is permitted to be tied up in an outside area, and no pet shall be left unattended for any period.

Pet owners are to keep their animals quiet, mannerly, without danger to other residents or guests, and shall be responsible for the pet's actions to not disturb other residents from their peaceful, quiet and enjoyable environment.

Pets are not permitted in the clubhouse, pools or recreational areas

New Dog park can only be used by "Resident Homeowners" that have filed Legacy pet owner paperwork with the office.

SELLING YOUR HOME: When selling your home, please make the office is aware of your intent to sell. We will not accept applications or process an application without the owner's permission which can be made by informing the office.

CONSTRUCTION:

Please remind your contractors of quiet hours until 8:30 am per the Rules and Regulations. Ask them to be courteous to neighbors of the homes they are working on when starting repairs in the morning hours. See part of Rule and

CONDUCT OF RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS

As respected residents of ARCADIA VILLAGE, it is vitally important that we respect our neighbor's rights to privacy, peace and quiet and the moral as well as legal rights they have to their property. In acknowledgement of this respect, disturbing noises of any nature whatsoever are not permitted at any time. Quiet is required between the hours of 10:00PM and 8:30AM. Televisions, radios, stereos, and related audio video devices must be always operated at a normal to low level so as not to disturb neighboring residents.

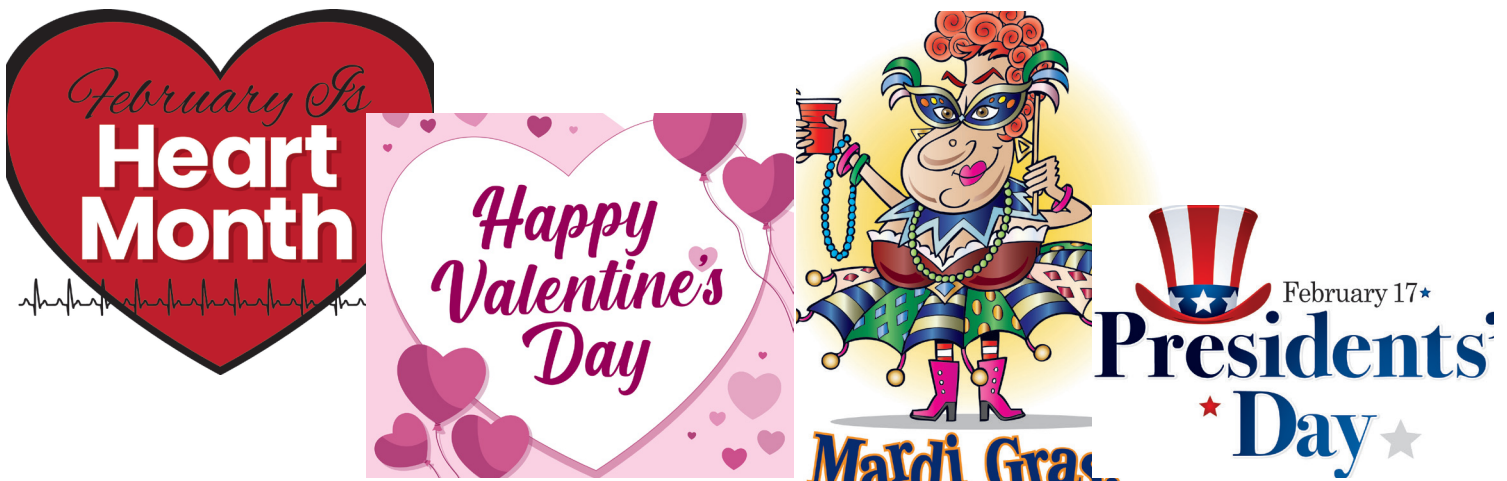
Of course, February also brings **Valentine's Day**, a celebration of love, kindness, and connection - whether that's with a partner, family, friend, or yourself.

- Discussion Topics from our January Town Hall Mtg:
 - Sylvia Clay presented an update regarding various subjects of interest and concern to the community.
 - Members were given the opportunity to ask questions.
 - Paula Stanton provided a status update regarding Blue Stream Cable and Internet.
 - Plan to provide another update at February meeting. Sylvia is working to get the price list for upgrades to cable packages from Blue Stream.
 - Discussion surrounding current legislation concerning the action needed to support House Bill 703 to change Chapter 723.
 - 703 has been filed by Reps Paula Stark and David Smith. It is a good bill for mobile homeowners.
 - There is an unequal bargaining position between the park owner and the mobile homeowners. Chapter 723 regulates the relationship between the homeowner and the park owner.
 - As the economic landscape with park ownership has changed, some updates to Chapter 723 are essential. There is a list of proposed changes in the FMO Watchdog Newsletter (Jan 17, 2026 Correction).
 - Chuck Varney offered copies for members to submit to legislation in support of this Bill. There is power in numbers! If you do nothing, then nothing will be done. You are your own best advocate. Make our voices heard.

RECIPE

BLUEBERRY YUM YUM

Ingredients:

3 cups graham cracker crumbs

1 1/2 sticks butter, melted

1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese

3/4 cups sugar

8 oz. cool whip

1 large can blueberry filling

(** You can use any fruit can, just not fresh or frozen fruit)

Directons:

Mix crumbs and butter together. Put half of this mixture in the bottom of a large pan. Cream together sugar, cream cheese and cool whip. Place half of this mixture over the cracker crumbs.

Next, spread the pie (blueberry) filling over this. Put the remainder of the cheese mixture over the pie filling. Top with the remaining cracker crumbs.

Refrigerate 2 or 3 hours or overnight.
