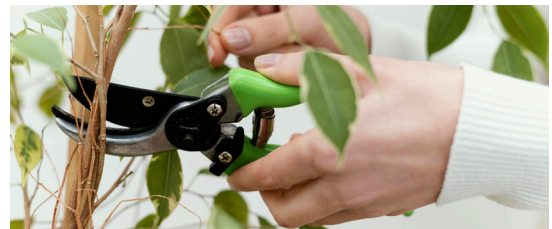

Swimming Pool Update

During the busy season, the pools experience increased use. To help maintain a clean and safe environment for everyone, please ensure that only **specialty made swim diapers** are used in the pool.

Regular diapers are not designed for swimming—they absorb water, become heavy, and can break apart, leading to sanitation issues and damage to pool filters which can cause pools to be shut down for up to a day or more. Swim diapers, on the other hand, are specifically designed to prevent leaks while keeping the pool water clean and equipment functioning properly.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping keep our community pools safe and enjoyable for all residents and your' visitors.

- **Non-golfers are not permitted** on any paths that are not marked in above map.
- **Non-golfers are not allowed** on the **Front 9 Golf Course.**
- **Fishing is permitted only** at **Lake Patty** or the **Gazebo Pond.**

RECIPE

BAKE WHILE YOU SLEEP COOKIES

Preheat oven to 350°

Ingredients:

- 2 egg whites
- Pinch of salt
- 1/4 tsp. cream of tartar
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 1/4 tsp. vanilla
- 1 cup chopped nuts
- 1 cup chocolate chips

Beat egg whites until stiff. Add sugar, 2 tablespoons at time beating well after each addition. Stir in vanilla, nuts and chocolate chips.

Drop on ungreased, foil lined cookie sheets. Put into oven and turn oven off immediately.

Suncoast Blood mobile will be here on March 3. The rules have changed for qualifications for donors. People on blood thinners are now eligible. You can donate whole blood as well as double red blood cells, and plasma. You have to wait 108 days between donating double reds. Doubles take the red blood cells and put the fluid back into you. The patient gets two pints of blood from one donor. 2026 marks our 20th year supporting the Suncoast Blood Drive Center. 550 pints of blood have been donated by Arcadia Villagers saving over 1500 lives.



Sign up in Cantina on the bulletin board for an appointment or call Wayne and Arline to sign up or questions of qualifications. We can help find an alternative for date and place for your donation. (Use code # 440 to give credit to Arcadia Village if donating at another Suncoast venue..) Every attempt will be made to keep your scheduled time.

The blood that we donate is used by a local hospital to save lives. CDC precautions are followed. You will receive free tests of cholesterol, blood type, blood pressure, temperature, pulse, Covid 19 antibodies and iron count (hemoglobin)

There is a donor rewards program which will earn points toward gifts for your donations. O negative gets the highest reward. Your blood is used by a local hospital to save lives. You never know when you or a loved one will need this precious gift. Blood supply is critically low.
